

- 8. Meeting of (NWP) experts



Why (added value)

- 1. More interactive
- 2. Better communications
- 3. Reach down to communities;
- 4. Connect knowledge and action (both ways);
- 5. Enhance capacity;
- 6. Reach the most vulnerable;
- 7. Professional communities of practice (health, tourism, DRR, food security, insurance, planners, economists, etc.)
- 8. Better mobilize strengths of organizations;
- 9. Build Parties' links to communities



Functions

- 1. Respond to Parties' requests and needs;
- 2. Execute MoUs or other agreements;
- 3. Hold good workshops and events;
- 4. Facilitate communication with "communities" and national bodies (e.g. universities, professional associations);
- 5. Find relevant expertise;
- 6. Co- oeprate with other UNFCCC bodies;
- 7. Help target the pledges;
- 8. Track pledge's effectiveness
