NAP EXPO: Launching of the national adaptation plan process in LDCs

The NAP Expo, which catalyses the launching of the national adaptation plan (NAP) process at the national level in LDCs, will take place on Sunday 9 June 2013, 10:00-18:00 hrs, in Beethovenhalle, Bonn, Germany, in conjunction with the thirty-eighth session of the Subsidiary Bodies.

Using the technical guidelines for the NAP process that have been prepared by the LEG (available on <http://unfccc.int/nap>), the objectives of the NAP Expo are to:

- Promote a common understanding of the NAP process by going through the NAP guidelines;
- Provide an opportunity for the LDCs to communicate their plans for the formulation of NAPs;
- Provide a platform for Parties, agencies and organizations to share information on their support to the LDCs on NAPs;
- Offer a forum for the exchange of experience and best practices on planning, prioritizing and implementation of adaptation.

The LEG welcomes the participation of representatives from LDCs and other Parties; the GEF and its agencies; adaptation practitioners; organizations; development agencies; regional centres and networks; as well as individual experts. The event is in direct response to a mandate by SBI 37 (FCCC/SBI/2012/33, paragraph 69).
