NAME GREEN CLIMATE FUND

TYPE Financial Mechanism of the Convention - UNFCCC

ESTABLISHED 11 December 2010 in Cancun, Mexico


- STAKEHOLDERS 194 Countries Signatories to the UNFCCC
 - GOVERNANCE Board + Secretariat + Independent Accountability Units Equal Board members from developing and developed countries
 - MANDATE To promote low-emission and climate-resilient development in developing countries

GCF business model


GCF Architecture

- USD 10.3 billion in pledges
- USD 9.9 billion in signed contributions
- 50/50 split between adaptation & mitigation
- Geographical balance
- 50% of adaptation resources for SIDS, LDCs and African States

Diversity of accredited entities



Largest dedicated climate fund globally




Roles of NDAs & focal points





Fit-for-Purpose Accreditation







Readiness: USD 1M

cap per country per year

<u>Expedite support</u> to formulate & implement national adaptation plans


(900 GCF NDAs/focal points are <u>invited to</u> <u>submit</u> <u>requests</u> for NAPs and/or other adaptation planning processes

From COP21 to COP22

Around 20 NDAs/focal points have formally expressed interest & proposals from Liberia & Nepal are in <u>final</u> <u>stages of</u> <u>approval</u>

Secretariat reviews proposal & financial management capacity to approve funding request


Legal arrangements concluded with delivery partner

31 October 2017	30 November 2017	1 January 2018
