

SUBMISSION BY THE GOVERNMENT OF INDONESIA

Pursuant to the Decision 5/CP.23 on Warsaw International Mechanism for Loss and Damage associated with Climate Change Impacts, the Government of Indonesia would like to submit views in the context of activity 1(a) of strategic work-stream (e) of the five-year rolling work-plan of the WIM Executive Committee as follows:

The scope of technical paper on types and nature of actions which finance may be required to address loss and damage associated with climate change impacts should include:

- Terms and definitions of loss and damage, including indicators of actions categorized to address loss and damage associated with climate change impacts from extreme events and slow onset events.
- 2. Development of technical instrument to identify potential loss and damage associated with climate change impacts.
- 3. Recommendations for the decision making process to address potential loss and damage associated with climate change impacts.
- 4. Capacity building and institutional strengthening including collecting best practises to cope with loss and damage associated with climate change impacts.
- 5. Development of technical instrument to identify distinction and linkages between loss and damage and the adaptation actions processes and implementation.
- 6. Quantifying economic and non-economic losses related to loss and damage associated with climate change impacts.
- 7. Clarity of institutional arrangements to support mobilization of financial support to address loss and damage, and the role of ExCom and existing financial mechanism under the Convention.
