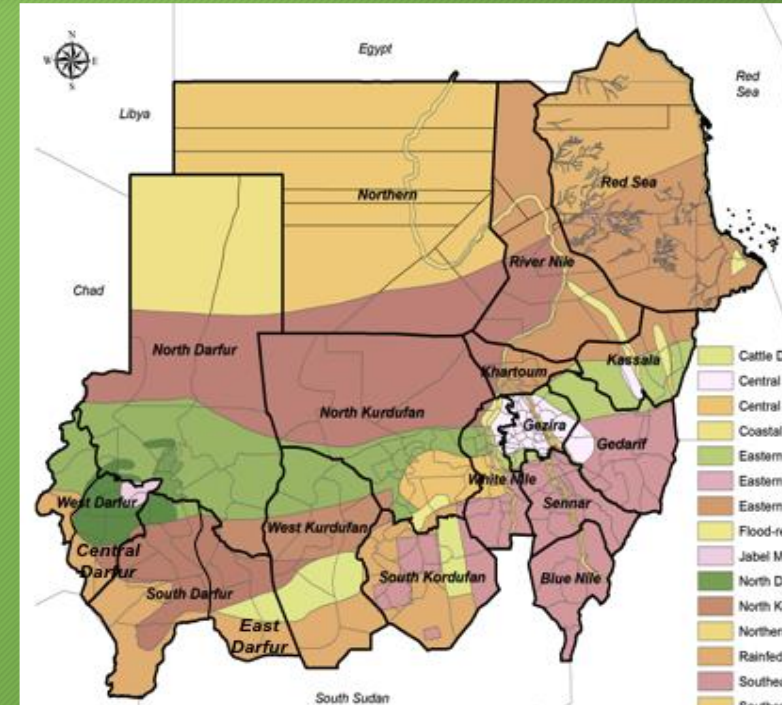

Introduction

- Commenced in 2011
- Scope: all 18 states of Sudan
- Overseen by the HCENR
- Total grant of USD 790,000 by DFID as part of UNEP Sudan Integrated Environment Project;
- PERSGA for vulnerability assessment of Sudan's coastal zone
- Fully endorsed at the national and state level
- Objectives: 1) reducing vulnerabilities; 2) Integration of adaptation into development planning
- Submitted to the UNFCCC through NAP Central in September 2016



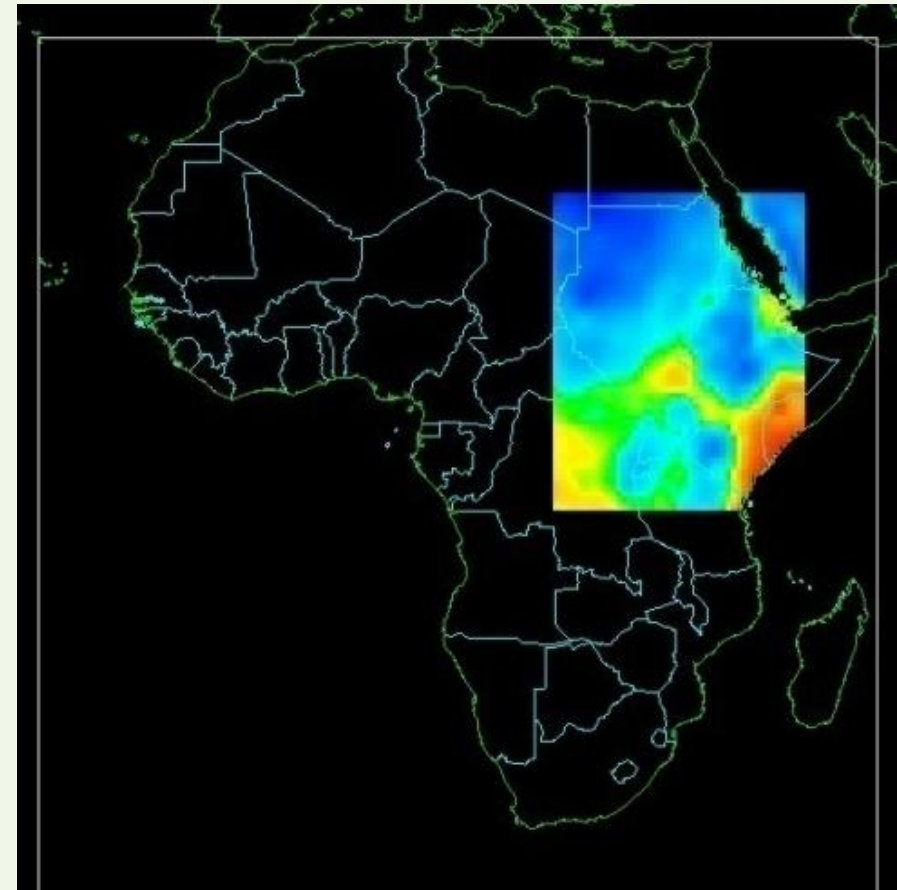
