- Acquiring proper data resolution, such as LIDAR data can be too expensive.
- Affordability of regional approaches at the local level.

# Responses

- Business opportunity within the SIDS group to acquire LIDAR data
- Available government Radar Satellite data could substitute
- An International intervention that pools financial and technology needs
- Synergy of skills are required
- Utilising the technical expertise within the UN to fill capacity requirements.

# Response cont'd

- Continuous Adaptation capacity building programmes.
- National Institutional Strengthening.
- Legal Framework
- Est. of a trust fund that can be capitalised to afford insurance. (Reg & Nat'l remember the resp. Issues and sources of funds?)
- Increase SIDS-SIDS cooperation

- SIDS financing facility for L&D at the international level.
- International funding for Regional Technical Support mechanism.
- Increase investments in SIDS-DOCK & energy efficiency.
- PSIDS engaging in UNSG Energy4All initiative.

# PSIDS Priorities cont'd

- SIDS-SIDS Technology Cooperation e.g. Acquiring LIDAR data.
- SIDS Recruitment Platform to assist with capacity constraints.
