- ❖ As part of its workplan the AC agreed to prepare an input document with information and recommendations for further actions for consideration by the COP
- ❖ Input document to draw on:
 - Results of the workshop on means of implementation (March 2015)
 - Other relevant work completed during 2013-2015
 - Adaptation good practices
 - Information communicated by Parties on their monitoring and review of adaptation actions, support provided and received, possible needs and gaps
- ❖ Inputs received from TEC and CTCN, LEG, CGE, SCF, GCF, GEF, AF, and NAP-GSP for LDCs and non-LDCs



II: Summary

- ❖ Emphasis is on:
 - NAP process
 - Entities and programmes under the UNFCCC
- ❖ Finance features prominently, in line with AC past activities (e.g. workshop in March 2015)
- ❖ Paper suggests to continue to use existing AC modalities to engage with other entities to scale up support to countries for implementation of adaptation actions
- ❖ List of potential activities for AC 2016-2018 workplan and recommendations for consideration by the COP
