II: Introduction and background

- ❖ Mandate: SBI 40 invited the AC, in collaboration with the LEG, to organize a workshop, drawing on experts and practitioners at different levels to share experiences, good practices, lessons learned, gaps and needs in the process to formulate and implement NAPs;
- ❖ Background material for the workshop was contained FCCC/SBI/2014/INF.14;
- ❖ COP 20 decided to explore options for enhancing reporting related to the process to formulate and implement NAPs as part of the workshop;
- ❖ SBI 42 (June 2015) welcomed the report and initiated consideration of options for enhancing reporting related to the process to formulate and implement NAPs; and
- ❖ Agreed to continue consideration on reporting at SBI 44 taking into account relevant information
