II: Introduction and background

- ❖ The paper is part of the work of the NAP TF, as agreed by the AC;
- ❖ Paper seeks to inform the NAP process;
- ❖ Suggested to prepare paper in two stages:
 1. Small number of experts and secretariat to review existing information, prepare 1st draft
 2. Draft to be reviewed by larger number of experts before passing revised draft to AC



II: Summary

❖ Suggested outline (in summary):

- General first part, introducing emerging topics on long-term adaptation planning and drawing parallels to long-term development planning
- Second part, in which country cases (representing developed and developing countries, including LDCs and SIDS) are used to illustrate the different experiences on the various topics
- Third part, which draws conclusions, including on possible next steps
