



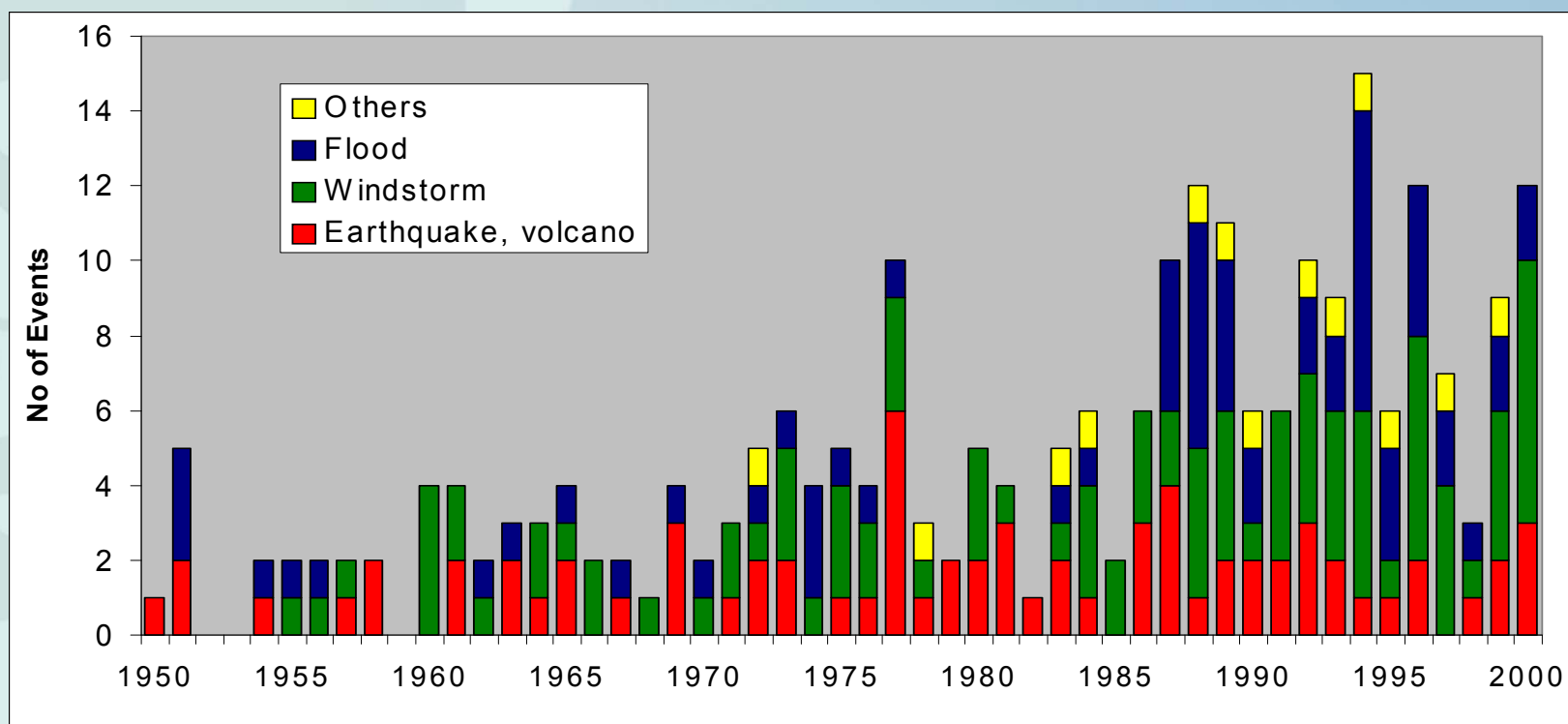

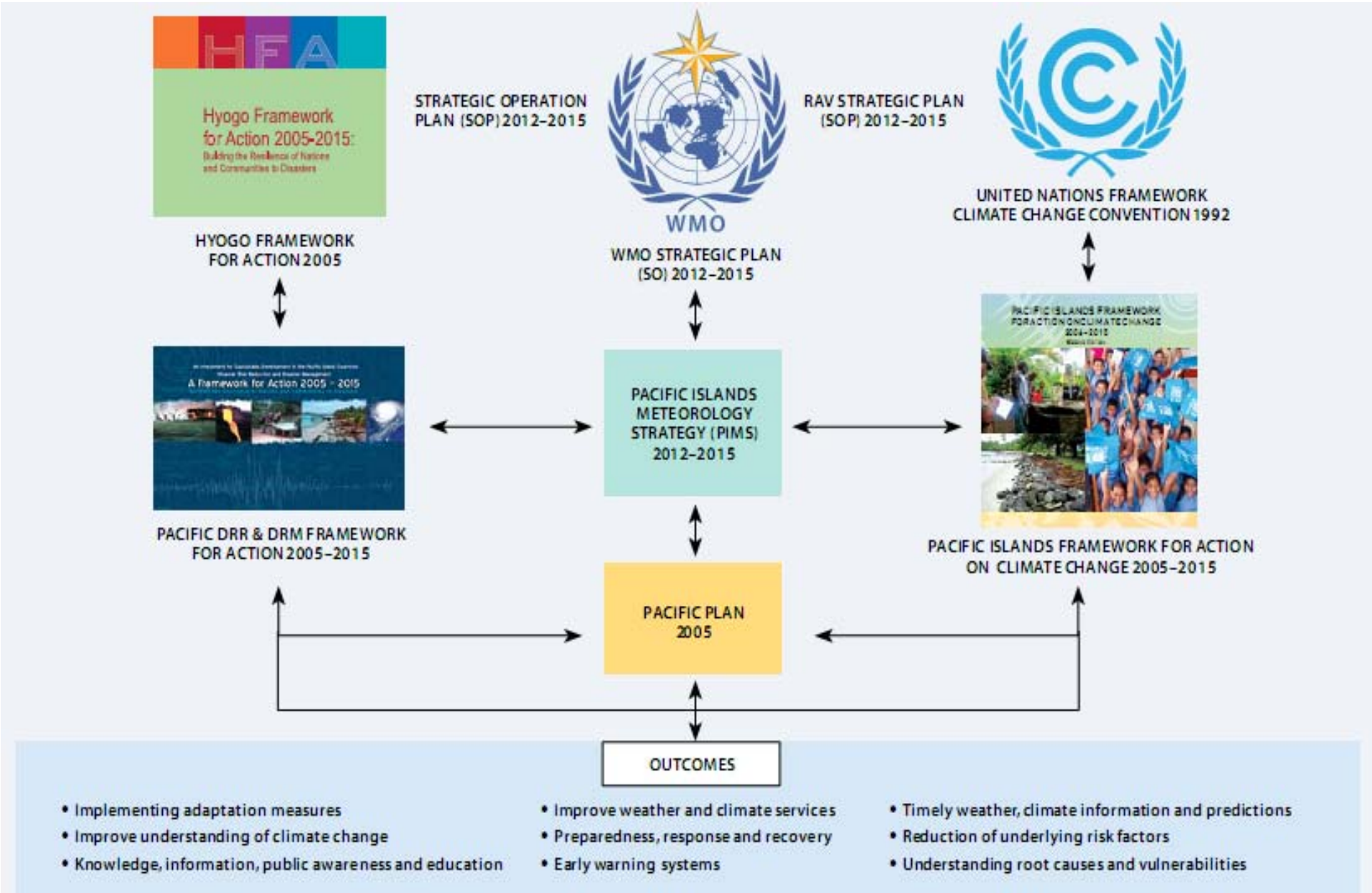

- avoid duplication and exhausting community in consultation



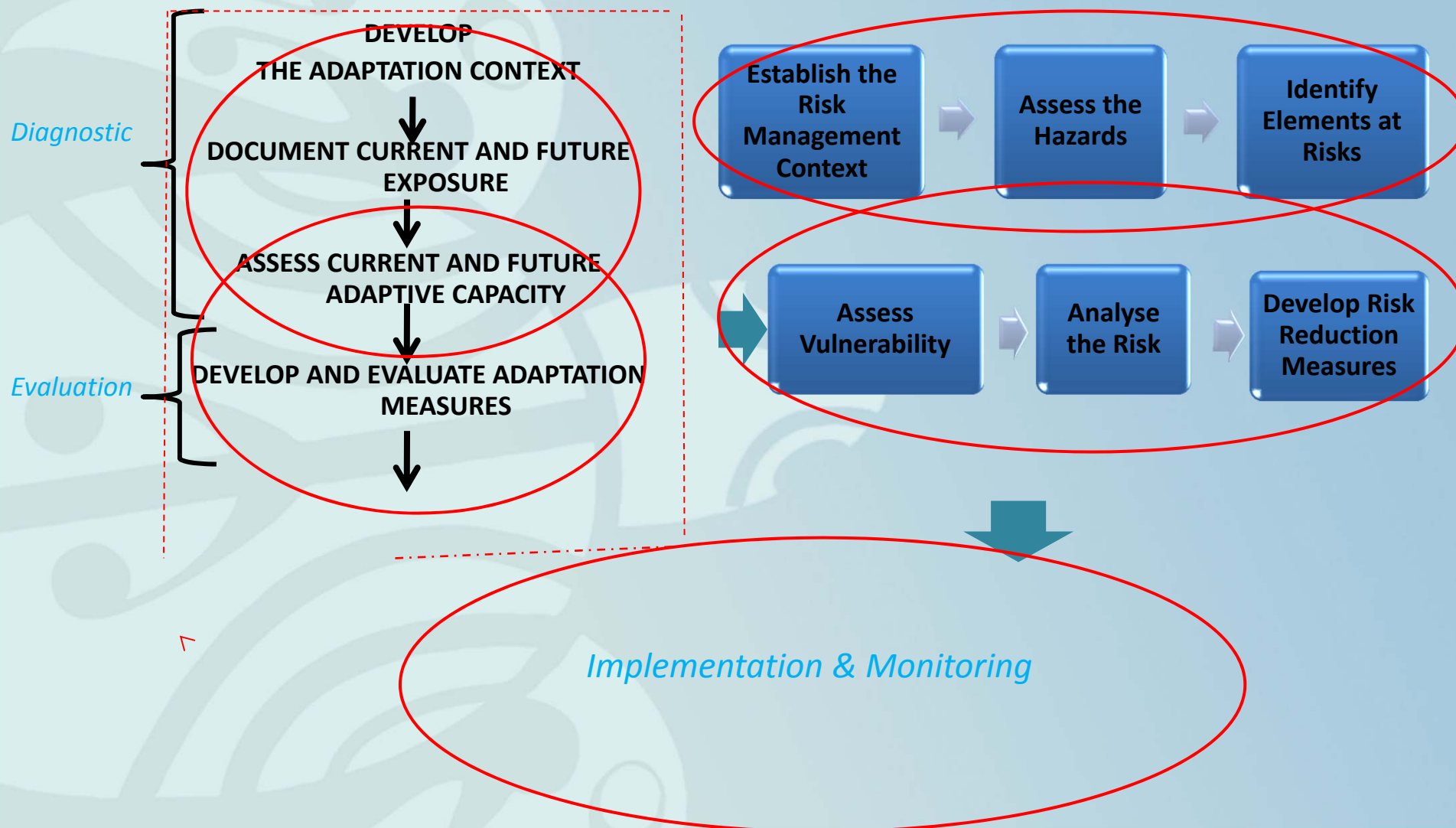

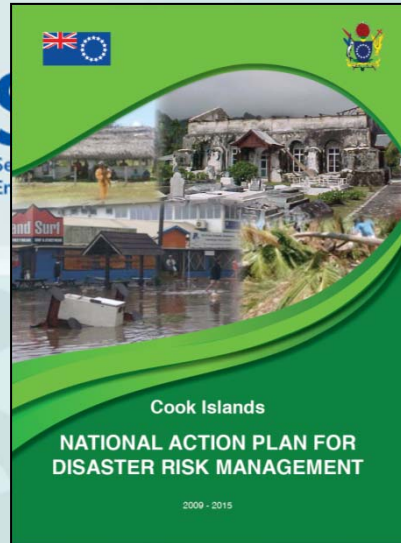
JNAP Development Process – 8 steps...
