

Indicative Framework for The Five-Year Rolling Work plan of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw International Mechanism

The activities for the Indicative Strategic Work Streams of the Five Year Rolling Work Plan of the Executive Committee of the Warsaw Intentional Mechanism have been identified in the light of earlier Initial Two Year Work Plan of the Executive committee. The following activities are proposed under the Indicative Framework for the Five Year Rolling Work Plan of the Executive Committee which may be carried out during the next five years building upon the Initial Two Year Work Plan:

Indicative Strategic Work Stream : (a) Slow onset Events		
Activities	Timeline	Expected Outcomes
i. Taking stock of relevant stakeholders/ departments/organizations that are working at national and sub-national levels on slow onset events and reviewing scope of their current efforts.	2017-18	Relevant Stakeholders/ organizations and their efforts carried out so far are mapped out
ii. Creating synergies through dialogues, coordination and cooperation among the relevant stakeholders with the objective to enhance, share and manage knowledge and understanding of slow onset events.	2017-18	Collaborative channels for collecting and sharing relevant information established, enhanced understanding of slow onset events and development of approaches to address effects of slow onset events.
iii. Collaboration between organizations and Executive Committee to facilitate access to information and database, also to share technologies to track the impacts of slow onset events.	2017-21	Collaboration on access to information and sharing of technologies enhanced
iv. Improvement of the state of knowledge, and capacity to address, slow onset events and their impacts, including the capacity of regional agencies.	2018-21	State of knowledge improved and capacity strengthened
