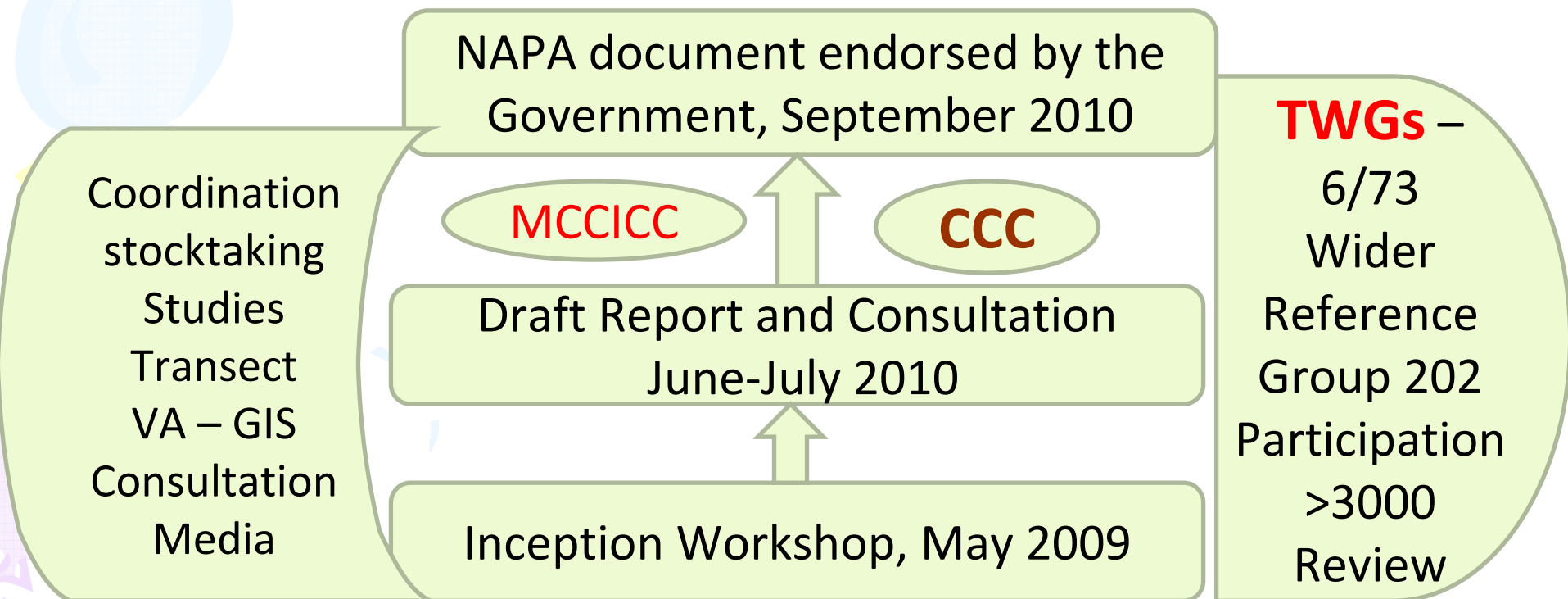

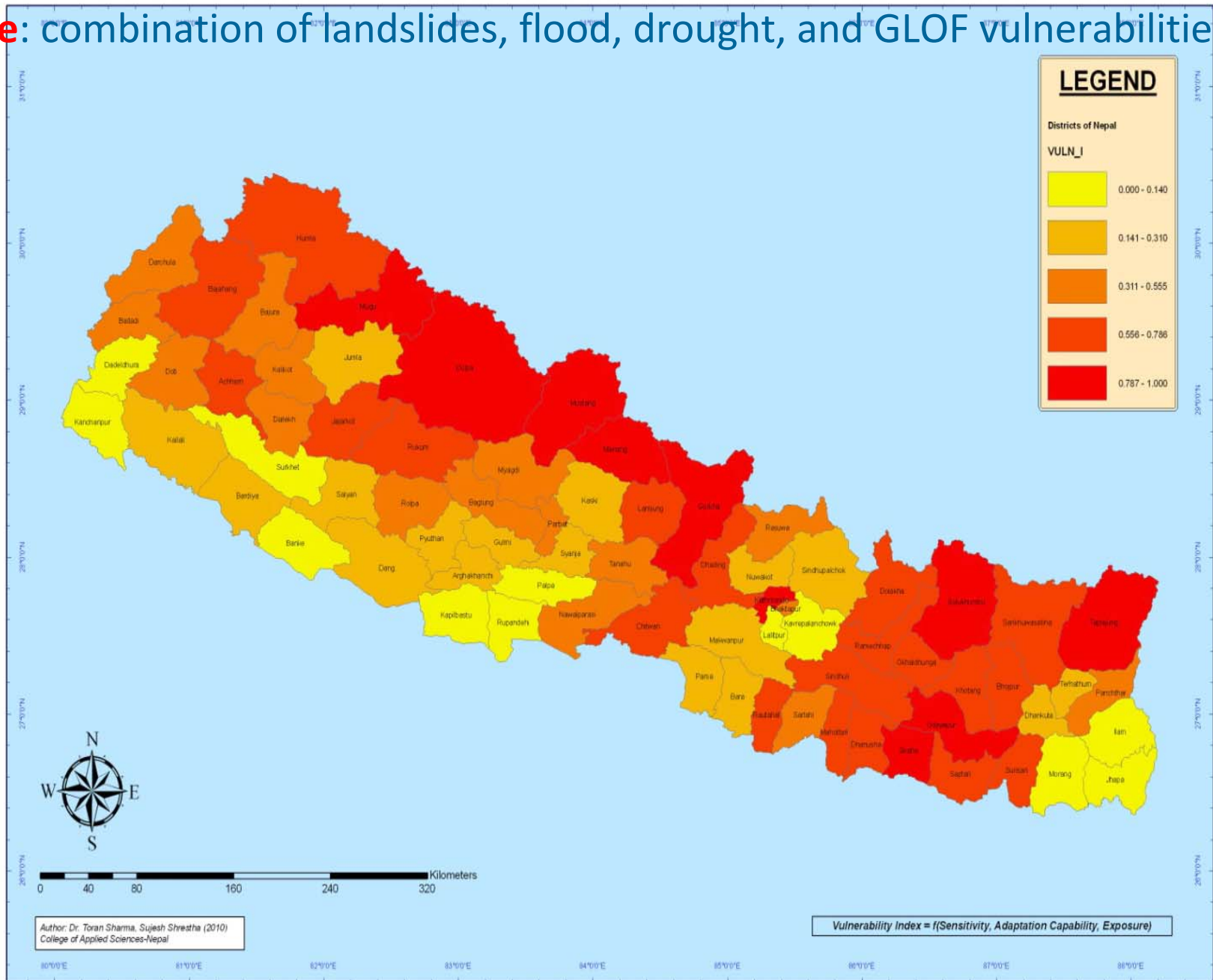

- **Objective** - mainstreaming climate change adaptation into national development for poverty reduction, livelihood improvement and resilience building

NAPA Prioritized Integrated Profiles

1. Increasing community based adaptation through integrated management of agriculture, water, forests and biodiversity
2. Building Adaptive Capacity of Vulnerable Communities Through Climate Resilient Agricultural Development
3. Community Based Disaster Management for Facilitating Climate Adaptation
4. GLOF Monitoring and Disaster Risk Reduction
5. Forest and Ecosystem Management for Supporting Climate Led Adaptation Innovations
6. Adapting to Climate Challenges in Public Health
7. Ecosystem Management for Climate Adaptation
8. Empowering Vulnerable Communities through Sustainable Management of Water Resource and Clean Energy Supply
9. Promoting Climate Smart Urban Settlement

NAPA Implementation

- NAPA - US\$ 350m estimated
- At least 80% of the total fund must reach to field/site
- Funding accessed within/outside the Convention Regime
- **LDC Fund** - Two PIFs submitted – one approved
- **Bilateral** - DFID/EU - community-based adaptation and USAID Hariyo Ban (Green Forests) Programme - climate adaptation component
- UNEP/UNDP/IUCN – Ecosystem-Based Adaptation Project - **Nepal**, Peru and Uganda
- PPCR – climate resilience and adaptation

Next Steps

- Finalisation of LAPA framework and manual – framework now under consultation
- Further alignment into national development – adaptation as national development agenda
 - Project development for NAPA Implementation
 - Implementation of Climate Change Policy, 2011
 - Strengthening of institutions and coordination mechanisms
 - Formulation of climate change strategy and framework for climate fund - started
