Challenges

- 1. Single stream/ focus funding
- Challenges of developing multi-level indicators that are acceptable across conventions but also at national level
 - a) National level -> sectoral focus (each sector with own priorities and indicators)

Best practices

- 1. 3 focal points in one ministry -> Botswana, Ethiopia, DRC
- 2. Building on existing programmes/ mainstreaming -> Extended Public Works South Africa, SIA Europe
- Evaluating multiple non-climate stressors local level but also beyond -> CI, UNCCD (social vulnerability thinking)

Recommendations/ Further work

- 1. Evaluate impacts of strategies/programmes until now (synergies)
- 2. Acknowledge, document, develop indigenous knowledge & use to build strategies together
- 3. Integrate synergies in M&E systems
 - a) High level indicators (global) between conventions + use same assumptions, scenarios, databases
 - b) Coordination, integration of indicators at multiple levels (Global -> National -> Local, use stakeholder input)
- 4. Greater integration in funds (e.g. GEF some synergy in SLM/SFM but more integration of indicators across and within)
- 5. Implementation national level -> develop principles for coordinated governance (link to 3 focal points)
