Ad Hoc Working Group on the Paris Agreement

Pre-sessional round table on agenda item 3: Further guidance in relation to the mitigation section of decision 1/CP.21¹

6 May 2017, Bonn, Germany

Pursuant to the request from the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Paris Agreement (APA) at the second part of its first session, I am pleased to notify Parties and Observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) and the Paris Agreement that the pre-sessional round table under APA agenda item 3 (Further guidance in relation to the mitigation section of decision 1/CP.21) will take place in Bonn, Germany, on **6 May 2017**. The date of the round table was set in consultation with Parties and it is reflected in the planning of pre-sessional group meetings.

With a view to making adequate arrangements for this event, interested Parties are cordially invited to inform the secretariat, via their national focal point, of the names of the delegates who will attend this round table. Parties are kindly requested to make this information available to the NDC logistics team, NDCs@unfccc.int, no later than 15 April 2017.

For developing countries only: The secretariat would also like to inform Parties that no funding for this meeting will be available beyond that provided to Parties in connection with the participation in the sessions of the subsidiary bodies to be held in Bonn, 8–18 May 2017.
