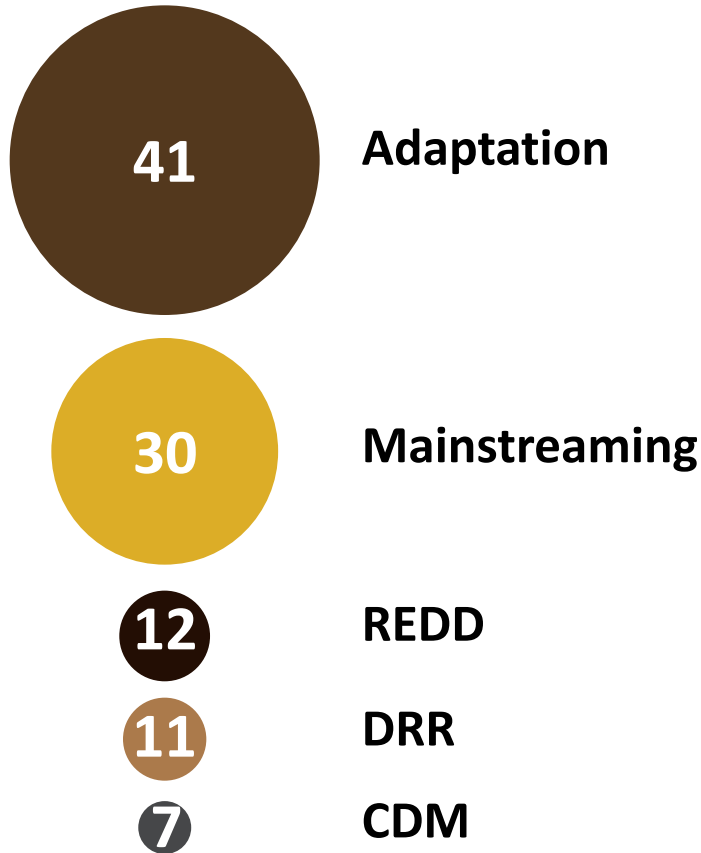

# Objectives

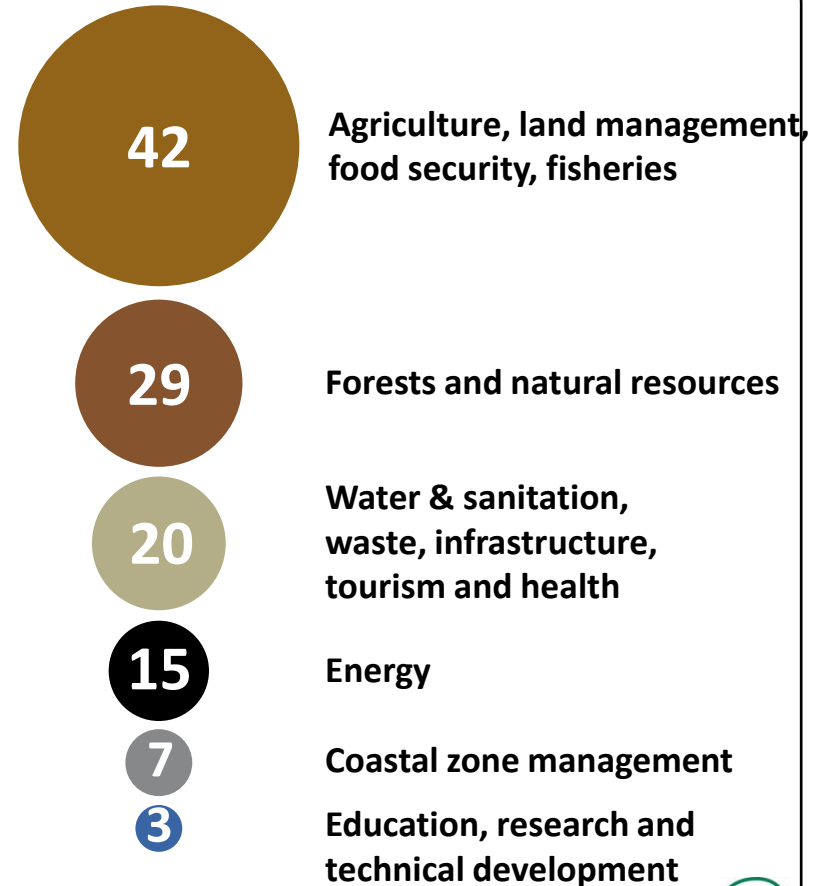

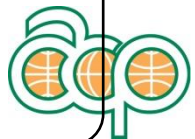
# GCCA Priorities
