

# Article 6 of the Climate Change Convention



**Public Education** awareness Sensitizes stakeholders **International** cooperation Imparts specific Enhances skills to **Training** capacity professionals building Public Stimulates & participation facilitate Access to participation Engages all information stakeholders

### New Delhi work programme (Decision 11/CP.8) 2002 - 2007



- Five-year work programme on Article 6
- Country-driven approach
- Phased approach by integrating Article 6 activities into existing climate change programmes/strategies
- Promote partnerships
- Encourage programmatic response by NGOs and IGOS
- List activities that Parties may wish to implement

# amended New Delhi work programme (Decision9/CP.13) 2007 - 2012



#### Differs from NDWP in

- 1. Scope of the work programme
  - Public awareness, public participation and public access to information split into 3 individual scopes.
- 2. Implementation
  - Preparation of national Article 6 plan of action
  - New subchapter on Regional and international efforts


### WHY WE ARE HERE TODAY?



- an intermediate review of progress in the implementation of the aNDWP in 2010 to evaluate its effectiveness and identify emerging gaps and needs
- organization of thematic regional and subregional workshops to share lessons learned and best practices:
  - Europe (Stockholm, Sweden, May 2009)
  - Asia and the Pacific (Bali, Indonesia, October 2009)
  - Latin America and the Caribbean (Bavaro, Dominican Republic, April 2010)
  - Africa (Banjul, The Gambia, September 2010)



# The amended New Delhi Work Programme Latest developments



SBI 32 – Conclusions agreed upon on Article 6 (FCCC/SBI/2010/L.5)

- endorsed the terms of reference for the intermediate review of progress in the implementation of the aNDWP
- encouraged Parties to consider opportunities for the engagement of relevant stakeholders in the national processes related to the intermediate review.
- requested the secretariat to prepare reports to support the intermediate review

### Funding


- No existing funding mechanism under UNFCCC

- Funding window under AWG-LCA currently subject of negotiations
