## Working Groups methodology

- Each group selects a moderator and a rapporteur
- Role of the moderator: facilitates discussion using Guiding Questions
- Role of the rapporteur: take notes during the discussion and submits a brief written summary
- A 10-minute oral summary of the discussions is provided either by the moderator or the rapporteur at the following Plenary
