Swenja is a Senior Research Fellow at the Grantham Research Institute on Climate Change and the Environment, part of the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE).

She is Programme Leader for the 'climate risk, insurance and private sector' work-stream, overseeing research projects from a multi-disciplinary field. Her work focuses on climate adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resilience, with a special interest in the role of the private sector, particularly insurance and public-private partnerships as well as adaptation policy and Loss and Damage of climate change.

She has published widely and is a contributing author to the IPCC. Swenja works closely with industry and policy makers at a global level, in a

developing country context, across the EU and within the UK, including recent work with the UNFCCC's Loss and Damage Work program, the Worldbank, the Bank of England and the UK Climate Change Risk Assessment project. In addition to her academic career Swenja has spent more than 10 years in the international insurance industry working on climate risks and risk management.
