

## **SUBMISSION BY THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA**

### **Implementation of all elements of decision 1/CP.17, (a) Matters related to paragraphs 2 to 6 (ADP)**

Responding to ADP invitation with reference to the Decision 1/CP.17, matters related to paragraphs 2 to 6 and ADP conclusions as adopted in COP 18/CMP 8, planning of work, paragraph 13(a)-(d), stated that the ADP invited Parties and accredited observer organizations to submit to the Secretariat, by 1 March 2013, information, views and proposals on matters related to the work of the ADP, including, inter alia, mitigation, adaptation, finance, technology development and transfer, capacity-building, and transparency of action and support.

Indonesia shares the views as follows:

- I. Application of the principles of the Convention
  - a. The 2015 agreement shall continue the effective implementation of the existing principles of the UNFCCC. These principles will be applied to actions, not limited to mitigation, but also on adaptation and means of implementation.
  - b. To ensure the effective implementation of such actions, the 2015 agreement shall consider access of each Party to support actions under the UNFCCC, namely mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation.
- II. The scope, structure and design of the 2015 agreement
  - a. Shall be legally binding and shall include a spectrum of commitments of each Party in terms of mitigation, adaptation and means of implementation.
  - b. Shall ensure a strong pull of compliance to all Parties.
- III. Work program 2013
  - a. The work under Workstream-1 is extremely important to ensure the global concerted effort in tackling climate change after 2020. Therefore, the work program has to be focused on the scope, structure and design of the 2015 agreement. Continuous consultations and informal discussion as well as workshops are still important to further clarify concerns of Parties. However, more in-depth discussion and deliberation on the scope, structure and design of the agreement need to be started in June session in Bonn.
  - b. The legally binding nature of the agreement to all Parties will need common understanding on the spectrum of commitments and its implication to the relevant

Parties. Workshops on this matter needs to be started by getting input from Parties and accredited observer organizations as early as possible but not later than the ADP June session in Bonn.

- c. To ensure the effectiveness of the work in 2013, the third session of ADP in 2013 shall start discussing enhanced actions for post 2020 taking into account the current social and economic development of Parties.
