






# The NDCs: universal response to the climate challenge

- 9 International Organizations


























# **Examples of current country engagement**

#### Pakistan: Institutional Support, Whole of Government

- Support the implementation of the National Climate Change Act 2017
- Foster interplay between federal and provincial level in the implementation of its NDC, energy sector
- Support the Ministry of Climate Change in coordinating climate change policy and implementation

#### **Columbia: Sectoral and territorial**

- Transform the priorities of Territorial Climate Change Action Plans into concrete actions,
- Operationalize sectoral priorities, i.e., developing implementation plans, detailing infrastructural needs and structuring financial arrangements.



# **Examples of current country engagement**

#### Morocco: Support national institution

- Coordinate climate expertise in the country and region with the Moroccan Climate Change Centre (4C)
- Strengthen the 4C through the NDC Special Facility to foster again whole of government approach to NDC implementation

#### Fiji: Stocktake and integration into national planning

- Plan technical assistance for revamping the NDC during revision period (facilitative dialogue)
- Review and integrate climate policy into the national development plan



### Cooperation with EC and MS

#### With EU Member States that signed up for the Partnership

- → Support Knowledge Products, for instance France (IDDRI), Sweden (SEI), Germany (German Development Institute GDI DIE)
- → Cooperate in Country

#### **Commission Programs**

- → Joint approaches in member countries through country facilitation
- → Build on mutual networks to further facilitate dialogue and coordination
- → Align and complement technical and financial assistance (Co financing PAGODACO)

**EUROCLIMA+:** Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Mexico, Panama, Honduras, and Peru

GCCA+ Mali, Mozambique, Sao Tome and Principe, and Uganda
