- A platform to help countries prepare and implement individual NAMAs:
 - Record information on NAMAs and support available
 - Facilitate matching
 - Recognize other NAMAs

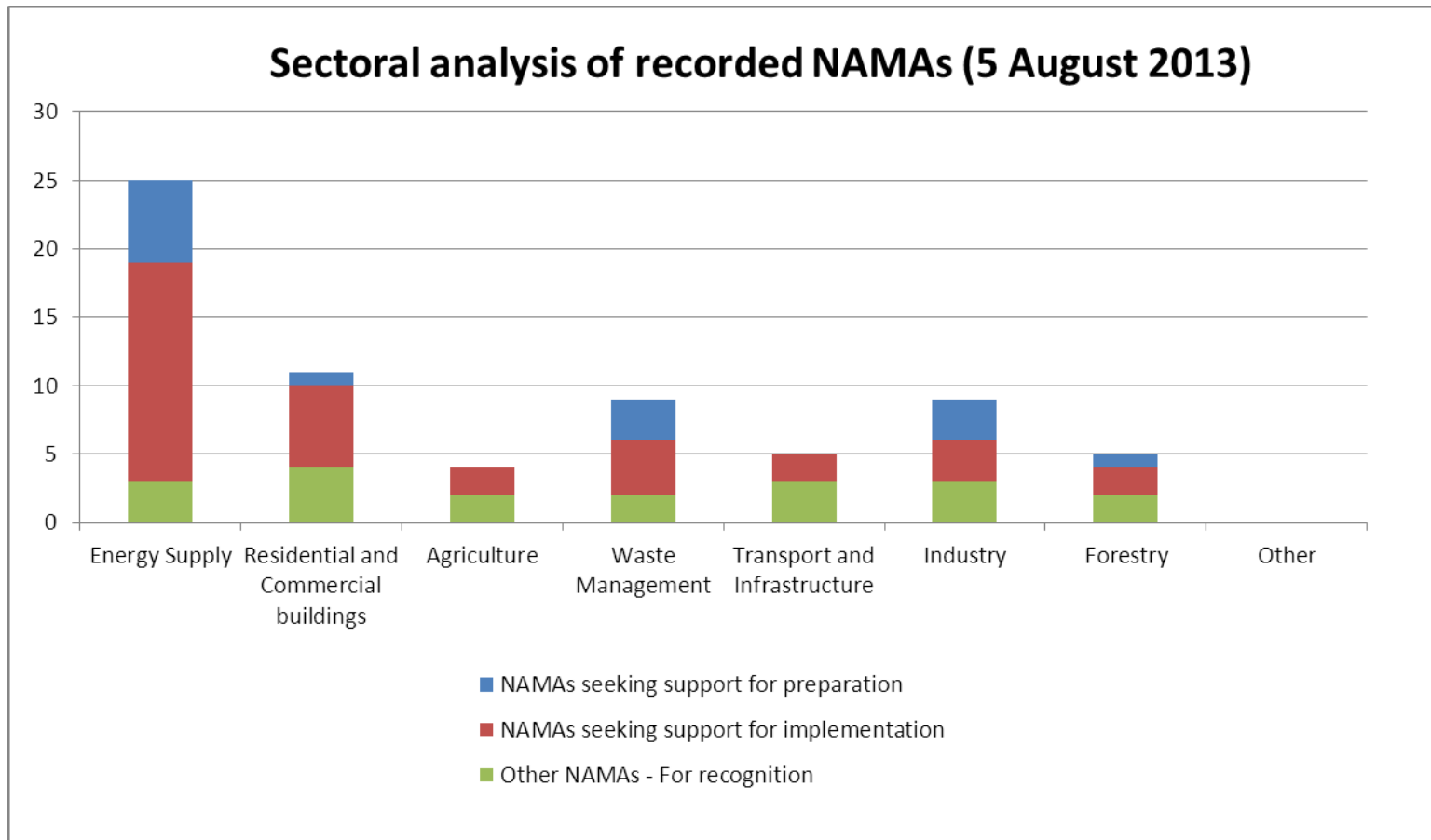


- Interim platform was made available in 2012
- NAMA Registry went live as an online prototype in April 2013
- The prototype is available to those with access rights
- Information from Parties is now being submitted and recorded in the registry
- First release of the public web based registry will be in October 2013



- Important note: Now that the registry is operational, NAMAs seeking support or NAMAs for recognition must be submitted via the registry rather than via email submissions.

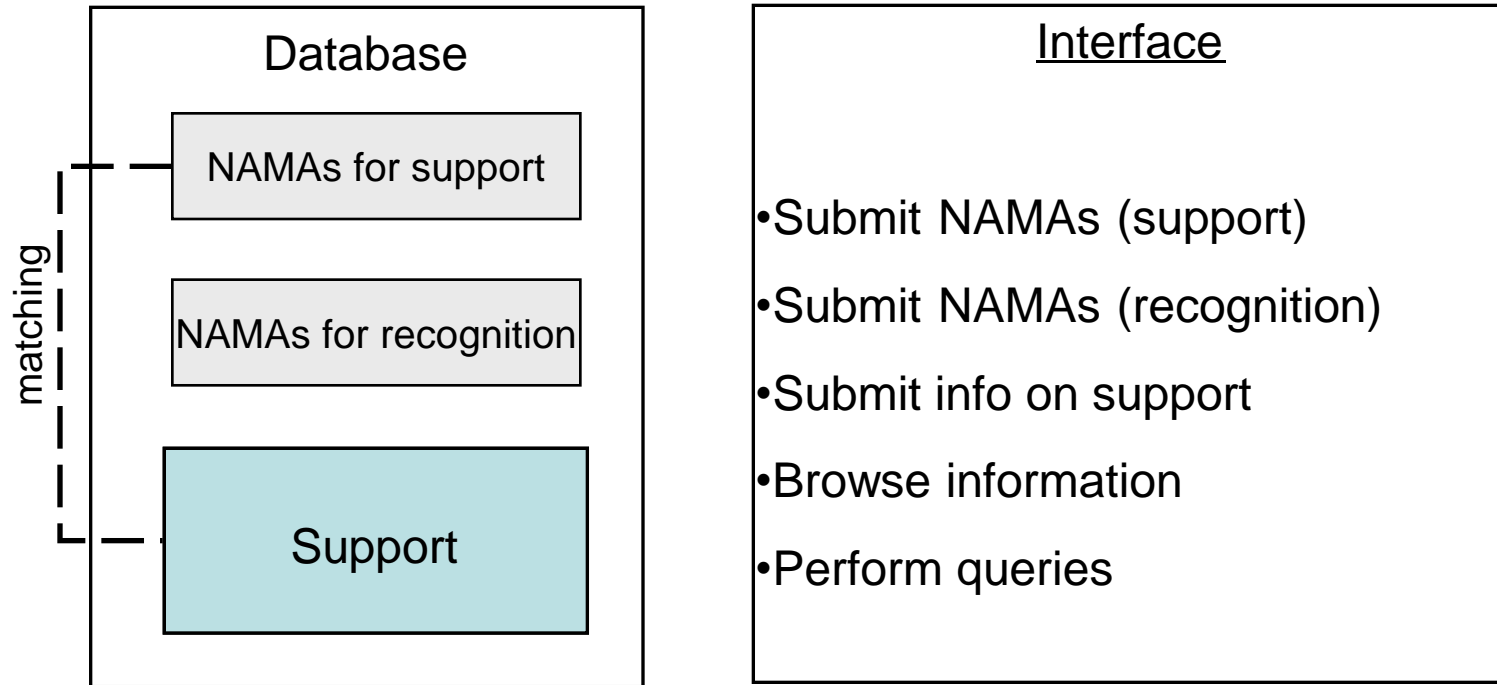

Three types of registry user:

a) NAMA approver:

- Full control over NAMA entries for that Party
- Can record, edit and delete NAMAs
- Can record support received by a NAMA

b) NAMA developer (actions subject to approval)

- Can record edit and delete NAMAs that they create (actions subject to approval)
- Can record support received by a NAMA

c) Support editor

- Can record information on support available and record when support is provided to a NAMA

- Public access to search and browse the registry will be added for the October release



Access rights:

a) NAMA approver:

- One set of access rights per non-Annex I party
- Have been distributed to non-Annex I national focal points by the secretariat as requested
- Can still be requested from NAMA-registry@unfccc.int

b) NAMA developer:

- As few or as many will exist as each non-Annex I party wish to create
- Allocated by non-Annex I parties at their discretion
- Can be requested from national focal points

c) Support editor:

- Available to any entity with a programme of support relevant to NAMAs
- Allocated on application to the secretariat by contacting NAMA-registry@unfccc.int
