Working group A: Capacity building, knowledge sharing and communication



- A.1. Systematic integration of gender perspectives/ considerations in climate change actions at the global, regional, national and subnational levels
  - a) Pilots in different regions to enable exchanges of knowledge between national level and local communities and indigenous people [e.g learing circles), including train the trainer
  - b) Develop knowledge products that are informed by the experiences from the pilot and good examples examples from other Parties
  - c) Technical workshop or meetings to share experiences and build capacity on the collection, analysis and use sex-disaggregated



- A.2. Enhanced knowledge, understanding and expertise on gender-responsive policy, planning and programming among Parties, bodies, UNFCCC secretariat and other stakeholders
  - Collect and analyze disaggregated data (sex, age, social groups, etc.) based on multi-stakeholder discussions at the sub-national and national levels to inform gender-responsive climate actions (ownership, buy-in, greater understanding among stakeholders)
  - b) Community of practice / community of experts to support the including knowledge sharing, communications, capacity building result area
