

Mitigation in 1.b.ii

- Nationally appropriate mitigation actions, as defined in the BAP, distinct from the mitigation commitments of 1.b.i.
- Abiding by the principles of the Convention and respecting the right to development and the legitimate priorities of sustainable development and poverty eradication in developing countries.
- Enhanced support from developed countries in new and additional financing, technology transfer and capacity building to enable enhanced actions by developing countries.

Mitigation in 1.b.ii

- Includes sustainable development actions that also reduce emissions.
- Enhanced support offered by developed countries in compliance with their UNFCCC commitments in accordance with article 4.7.
- Expresses the principle of common but differentiated responsibilities: all contribute to the mitigation effort, but mitigation by AI Parties and by NAI Parties are distinct in magnitude and legal nature.

Mitigation in 1.b.ii

- Measurable, reportable and verifiable mitigation actions are only those enabled by measurable, reportable and verifiable support.
- Channel support for mitigation actions by developing countries, based on financial, technology and capacity building mechanisms, as proposed by the G77 and China.

Mitigation in 1.b.ii

- NAI Parties can voluntarily propose actions for mitigation support.
- Mitigation actions by developing countries based on their own resources should be recognized.
