1. The branch may wish to consider the provisional agenda for adoption.

2. The branch may wish to consider the organization of its work for the meeting, including its schedule.

### **4. Effects of a Party's withdrawal from the Kyoto Protocol on its reporting obligations**

3. At its twenty-sixth meeting, the branch continued its discussion on the matter of Canada's withdrawal from the Kyoto Protocol and its effects on Canada's reporting obligations under the Protocol.<sup>1</sup> It agreed to include the matter on the agenda of its twenty-seventh meeting, at which time it expected the report on the individual review of the annual submission of Canada submitted in 2014 (Canada's 2014 ARR) to be publicly available. Canada's 2014 ARR was published on 23 April 2015 and forwarded to the members and alternate members of the branch on 28 April 2015.<sup>2</sup>

4. The branch will be invited to consider this matter, taking into account Canada's 2014 ARR.

### **5. Delay in the submission by a Party included in Annex I of its national inventory report for 2014**

5. At its twenty-sixth meeting, the branch considered the information provided in Monaco's 2014 ARR.<sup>3</sup> It requested the secretariat to invite the lead reviewers of the expert review team (ERT) that conducted the review of Monaco's 2014 annual submission to its twenty-seventh meeting, with a view to understanding the reasons for the team's decision not to indicate a question of implementation with respect to Monaco's late submission of its National Inventory Report, in light of paragraph 3 (a) of the annex to decision 15/CMP.1 in relation to paragraph 8 of the annex to decision 22/CMP.1.

6. Mr. Domenico Gaudio, one of the lead reviewers of the ERT that reviewed Monaco's 2014 annual submission, will be attending the twenty-seventh meeting of the branch.
