**Twenty-seventh meeting**

6 September 2015  
Bonn, Germany

**Report on the meeting**

**1. Opening of the meeting**

1. Mr. Gerhard Loibl, vice-chairperson of the enforcement branch, declared the meeting open at 14:32. He informed the meeting that the chairperson of the branch, Ms. Rueanna Haynes, was unable to attend the meeting. Consequently, in accordance with rule 6, paragraph 1, of the “Rules of procedure of the Compliance Committee of the Kyoto Protocol”,<sup>1</sup> the vice-chairperson chaired the meeting.

2. At the request of the chairperson, the secretariat provided information on participation and quorum, as well as key administrative, logistical and housekeeping arrangements. The secretariat confirmed that there was a quorum for the meeting, that the meeting was being webcast live on the Internet, and that an audio recording was being made of the entire meeting.

3. The enforcement branch welcomed Mr. Domenico Gaudio, one of the lead reviewers of the expert review team (ERT) that had conducted the review of Monaco’s annual submission submitted in 2014 (Monaco’s 2014 annual submission). It noted that one observer had registered for and was present at the meeting.

**2. Adoption of the agenda**

4. The branch reviewed and adopted the provisional agenda (CC/EB/27/2015/1).

**3. Organization of work**

5. The branch agreed to organize its consideration of the items on the agenda in the order in which they had been set out in the agenda as adopted.

**4. Effects of a Party’s withdrawal from the Kyoto Protocol on its reporting obligations**

6. The branch noted that Canada’s national inventory report and common reporting format tables submitted on 11 April 2014 were reviewed in accordance with the “Guidelines for the technical review of greenhouse gas inventories from Parties included in Annex I to the Convention” (decision 19/CP.8). The branch also noted that its mandate was limited to consideration of questions of

implementation from reviews under Article 8 of the Kyoto Protocol and therefore agreed to complete its consideration of this item.

### 5. Effects of a Party's late submission of an annual inventory

7. At the request of the branch made at its twenty-sixth meeting, the secretariat invited the lead reviewers of the ERT that conducted the review of Monaco's 2014 annual submission to attend the meeting.<sup>2</sup> At the invitation of the chairperson, Mr. Gaudioso, one of the lead reviewers, outlined the reasons for the ERT's decision not to indicate a question of implementation with respect to Monaco's late submission of its national inventory report.

8. The branch took note of the explanation provided by Mr. Gaudioso and agreed to complete its consideration of this item.

### 6. Other matters

9. Taking into account the expected workload in the first half of the year, the branch agreed to meet in the period from late May to early June 2016. It requested the chairperson and vice-chairperson to finalize the schedule of its meeting in consultation with the members and alternate members and the secretariat.

### 7. Closure of the meeting

10. The chairperson of the branch declared the meeting closed at 15:39.
