Subject: Submission of the plan for reinstatement of Croatia's compliance related to the calculation of the assigned amount and the commitment period reserve

In accordance with the notice of 10 August 2011 regarding further procedure following Croatia's withdrawal of its appeal against the final decision of the Enforcement branch of the Compliance Committee of the Kyoto Protocol contained in document CC-2009-1-8/Croatia/EB, we are submitting a plan for the calculation of the assigned amount and the commitment period reserve of Croatia in accordance with Article 3, paragraph 7 and 8 of the Kyoto Protocol and the modalities for the accounting of assigned amounts in decision 13/CMP.1. as follows:

With the aim of the resolving the issue of noncompliance, Croatia intends to submit the letter by which it will withdraw its disagreements with the expert review team conclusions, related to Croatia's calculation of its assigned amount and calculations of the commitment period reserve under Article 7, paragraph 4, of the Kyoto Protocol (decision 13/CMP.1).

The above mentioned letter will be sent upon receiving a positive opinion from the Enforcement branch that the proposed step would lead to the resolution of the question of implementation and remedy non-compliance.

Furthermore, by this letter Croatia requests the Enforcement branch to reinstate its eligibility, pursuant to paragraph 2 of section X of procedures and mechanisms.
