

The Latin-American Forum on REDD was launched officially in February 13th, 2009, during the *I Workhop South-South for Cooperation of REDD Activities* occasion in which specialists in REDD of Latin-American countries and the United States shared their knowledge and experiences in REDD initiatives in Latin America.

The Forum aims the construction of an open net whose goal is the reduction of barriers among Latin-American countries in regard to REDD as well as the preparation for the international negotiations to be held until the end of the year and during the COP15-MOP5, in Copenhagen. The Forum will include representatives of NGOs, local Governments and indigenous people along with others possible interested parts.

As chosen for the entities present during the Workshop, The Amazonas Sustainable Foundation (FAS), a NGO based in the Brazilian Amazon, is responsible to promote the Forum and to get financial resources. The Professor Virgilio Viana (General Director of FAS) is the General Coordinator, and Thais Megid is the Executive Secretary.
