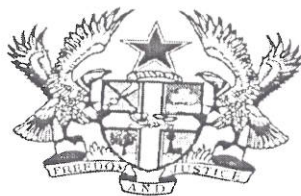

**GHANA'S VIEWS ON THE DRAFT PROPOSAL BY THE CHAIR TO  
FACILITATE PREPARATIONS FOR NEGOTIATIONS (AWG-KP)**

We have for reference your Message with reference no: ODRS/AWGLCA 12/AWGKP14/10 of 15<sup>th</sup> October 2010 on the above subject matter and have the pleasure to transmit the following as the official position/ view of Ghana on the Chair's Text to facilitate the ongoing negotiations.

1. Ghana supports a two track (separate) agreements must be maintained in the entire negotiations and not merged

- a) Kyoto Protocol agreement – KP track
- b) Convention (UNFCCC) agreement - Convention track

2. Ghana also favours continuing the negotiations towards legally binding agreements *for at least the next six months.*

3. We call for respect for the mandate of the AWG-KP to guarantee the continuation of the Protocol (amendment of Article 3.9 and other related Articles)

The issues on emissions reductions figures & mechanisms for Annex I Parties have to be considered only under AWG-KP developed country Kyoto Protocol Parties and under the LCA 1b (i) for Non - K.P Annex I countries for comparability purpose.

4. We also support

- The geographical distribution of Clean Development Mechanism (CDM)
- Cap on the use of LULUCF for Annex 1
- The level of emissions by Annex I Parties Emission reductions of 52% by 2017, 65% by 2020, 80% by 2030, 100% (i.e. carbon neutral) by 2050 by

all developed countries domestically compared to 1990 levels and 90 % of these reduction should be from domestic efforts by Annex I Parties

- Proposes maintaining the base year: 1990
- Second commitment period should be for 5 years
