OVERALL OBJECTIVES

- Exploring further mitigation efforts
- Strengthen the international technological cooperation and transfer of technology.
- Effective and efficient mitigation by sector based actions as well as by cross border sharing of BATs/BPs
- Strengthen cooperation on technological and financial aspects
- A complement instruments
- Contribute in achieving the ultimate objective of the Convention

BASIC PRINCIPLES

- Taking into account the social, economic condition and other relevant factors at national level
- A Complement tools to further reaffirm the principle of common but differentiated responsibilities (CBDR) and Respective Capabilities

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

- Enhance the implementation of Article 4, paragraph 1 (c) of the Convention
- Bottom up analysis of mitigation potentials
 - Useful tools for calculating reduction targets
 - Can provide scientific and objective knowledge that contribute further to the formulation of an effective future regime
- Not to be used for quantification of national target. Complement rather than replace national strategies and mid-term goals

- Not applying uniform standard for developed and developing countries equally
- As analytical tool to inform national mitigation efforts and not to replace the national targets
- Should not lead to commitments for non Annex I Parties
- Should not constitute as means for unjustifiable discrimination or disguised restriction of access of non-Annex I parties to international trade
- Should contribute in enhancing MRV actions to ensure environmental integrity

- Definition and its integration under the Convention
- Clarify further of “cooperative sectoral approach” in BAP
- Reflection of CBDR and RC in transnational agreement on global sector approach
- Introduction sectoral approach within global market
- Introduction sectoral approach outside global market
- Derivation of MRV to be adapted in sectoral approach
- Define the required associated instruments for the implementation of sectoral approach
