Indicative questions

Enhanced action on capacity-building

In the text to facilitate negotiations among Parties (FCCC/AWGLCA/2010/6), enhanced action on capacity-building is presented in paragraphs 44 and 45 of chapter I (annex I) and in chapter IV (annex IV). In relation to paragraphs 44-45 of chapter I and paragraph 5 of chapter IV:

- 1) How should capacity needs of developing countries be supported?
- 2) Would existing arrangements/institutions/bodies be sufficient to facilitate the effective delivery of capacity-building support to developing countries or would new institutional arrangements be required?

Policy approaches and positive incentives on issues relating to reducing emissions from deforestation and forest degradation in developing countries; and the role of conservation, sustainable management of forests and enhancement of forest carbon stocks in developing countries

In the text to facilitate negotiations among Parties (FCCC/AWGLCA/2010/6), Chapter VI (Annex VI), p33-36, policy approaches and positive incentives on issues relating to reducing emissions from deforestation and forest degradation in developing countries; and the role of conservation, sustainable management of forests and enhancement of forest carbon stocks in developing countries are addressed. Parties are invited to focus their intervention on the following questions to move the discussion forward under this issue.

- (a) What remains to be done to begin developing and/or implementing national strategies or action plans, policies and measures and capacity building (“readiness activities”)?
- (b) How would support be provided for:
 - i. the development and implementations of national strategies or action plans, policies and measures and capacity building (“readiness”) to prepare developing countries for full implementation of REDD-plus actions?
 - ii. full implementation of REDD-plus actions?
