> CDM Executive Board

Role

- Current M&P
 - ➤ "Board shall supervise the CDM" (para 5 of 3/CMP.1)
- Inputs
 - ➤ Clarify the supervisory role of the Board and delegation of operational matters to support structure
 - ➤ Better definition of the relationship between the Board and its support structure



> CDM Executive Board

Membership

- Current M&P (para 8 of 3/CMP.1)
 - Nomination by relevant constituencies (Party constituencies)
 - Shall possess appropriate technical and/or policy expertise and shall act in their personal capacity
 - > Period of two years, max. two consecutive terms (in same seat)
 - No pecuniary or financial interest in any aspect of a CDM project activity or DOE
- Current situation
 - > Terms of reference of the Board (3/CMP.6)
 - ➤ No specific reference to gender balance (cf. Decision 23/CP.18 endorsed by CMP)



> CDM Executive Board (cont.)

Membership (cont.)

- Inputs
 - Membership aspects on governance are closely interlinked
 - > Transparent nomination process
 - > Representation in the Board of private sector and civil society
 - Not allow nominations from representatives with interest in the CDM
 - > Apply limits to term of office to individuals
 - > Full time Chair and Vice-Chair
 - No alternates
 - > Code of conduct, inclusion in the M&P and further elaboration
 - Harmonization and unification of CDM and JI governing bodies



> Host party DNA approval and oversight

- Current M&P
 - Party authorizes public/private entities to participate in project activities
 - ➤ DOE to validate written approval of voluntary participation from the DNA of each Party involved, including confirmation by the host Party that the project activity assists in achieving sustainable development
 - ➤ No oversight during implementation of project activities
 - ➤ No process for withdrawal of letters of approval



> Host Party DNA approval and oversight

- Inputs
 - ➤ Need for process for withdrawal or suspension of letters of approval
 - ➤ Letters of approval to contain the start date and the end date for validity, as applicable and clear conditions of withdrawal
 - > Host countries to monitor the implementation of project activity
 - DNAs to provide criteria related to national regulations that the project activity must follow
 - ➤ Host country to list E+/E- policies
 - Definition of host Party approval
 - > Required minimum content of letters of approval



- > Appeals mechanism (against Board's decisions)
 - Currently under SBI discussions
