
Outreach WG III IPCC 2007-2008, mitigation

Some observations

- There is a continuous need to explain the findings of the AR4 to various audiences
- Regional needs are met with regional authors
- Attention is shifting to adaptation and mitigation options, costs and link with sustainainable development
- Need for more case-study results in the next Assessment Report
- Outreach and education in climate change remains weak link

New Scenarios for the AR5

- IPCC to play a 'catalytic' role
- New approach compared to SRES
 - Reference concentration pathways (RCPs)
 - Parallel development of scenarios through climate models and emission projections
 - New generation HR climate models, better integration socio-economics, vulnerability, impacts, adaptation van mitigation

Products

- Reference Concentration Pathways
- High resolution climate model ensembles and pattern scaling
- New integrated assessment scenarios
- Global narrative storylines
- Integrated scenarios

Process

- 2008: Preparatory phase
- 2010: Parallel modelling phase
- 2012: Integration phase
- 2013: Publication lag
- 2013-2014: Feed into AR5
