



## Work programme resulting from the relevant requests contained in decision 1/CP.21

Note on the progress tracker (19 January 2018)

### 1. Background and purpose

In their Reflections Note of 6 May 2016, the Presidents of the twenty-first and twenty-second sessions of the Conference of the Parties (COP) requested the secretariat to develop a tool to track progress (“progress tracker”) made in relation to the work programme resulting from the relevant requests contained in decision 1/CP.21. The SBI at its 46<sup>th</sup> session invited the secretariat to regularly update the progress tracker<sup>1</sup> and make it available to Parties.

The progress tracker is aimed at: (1) providing up-to-date information on the implementation of mandates in Decision 1/CP.21; and (2) providing information on next steps.

The progress tracker is designed to complement the information contained in an online platform providing an overview of the work of the COP, Subsidiary Bodies and Constituted Bodies on the work programme under the Paris Agreement.<sup>2</sup>

### 2. Approach to the development of the progress tracker

- The scope of the progress tracker is limited to mandates contained in Decision 1/CP.21.
- The progress tracker includes the following information:
  - A summary of each mandate
  - The responsible bodies/actors
  - Any associated timelines
  - Status of implementation, and
  - Next steps.
- For ease of reference, a color code is used to cluster the mandates as they relate to the articles of the Paris Agreement, sections V (Enhanced Action Prior to 2020) and VI (Non-Party Stakeholders) of Decision 1/CP.21. These clusters are not intended to influence the organization of the work of the mandated body(ies) nor that of any session.

- The information on *Status* refers to the latest steps/deliverables (as available by the date of issue of the progress tracker) associated with a mandate. For mandates affected by Decision 1/CP.23 hyperlinks to an online platform are provided.
- The information on next steps summarizes upcoming developments associated with each mandate.
- The progress tracker contains links to relevant documents and/or web pages, including documents and/or web pages relevant for the work of the Conference of the Parties, subsidiary and constituted bodies.
- Consistent with the SBI invitation referred to above, the secretariat will regularly update the progress tracker and make it available on the UNFCCC website. The information contained in the progress tracker reflects the situation at its date of issue.
- The progress tracker uses an asterisk (\*) to identify mandates with updated activities, compared to the last issued version.
