**Revised notification of contributions for the year 2004**

The secretariat of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) has the pleasure to enclose herewith a table (Annex I) reflecting the revised indicative contributions for 2004, based on the programme budget for the biennium 2004–2005 adopted by the Conference of the Parties at its ninth session. Also enclosed (Annex II) is the revised scale of contributions based on the United Nations scale of assessment for 2004 as revised by the General Assembly in December 2003.

The amounts due on 1 January 2004 include outstanding contributions for previous years, if applicable. Any amounts received in advance have been taken into consideration. Contributions to the contingency budget for conference services are not included in the amounts due, following the decision by the General Assembly to cover such costs from the regular budget of the United Nations.

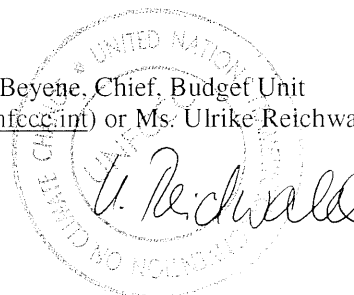
