INFORMATION TO PARTIES

Nomination of officers for the Ad hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP)

This is to inform Parties to the Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change that during the eleventh session of the Ad hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP 11), scheduled to be held in Bonn, from 9 to 11 April 2010, Parties will be invited to elect the officers of the AWG-KP.

At the fifth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP 5), which was held in Copenhagen in December 2009, consultations were undertaken with the Chairs of Regional Group on the nomination of officers to be elected to the AWG-KP. During the session, the secretariat received the following nominations:

- For the position of Chair:
 - Mr. John W. Ashe (Antigua and Barbuda), nominated by the Latin American and Caribbean States (GRULAC)
- For the position of Vice-Chair:
 - No nomination received
- For the position of Rapporteur:
 - Mr. Miroslav Spasojevic (Serbia), nomination by the Eastern European States

Consultations on the election of officers of the AWG-KP will resume at AWG-KP 11. The President of COP 15/CMP 5 will designate an official to conduct the consultations on her behalf. Parties will be invited to consult and agree on the nominees to be elected. During their consultations, Parties are invited to recall decision 36/CP.7 and give active consideration to the nomination of women for election to the AWG-KP. Following completion of the consultations, the AWG-KP will be invited to elect its Chair, Vice-Chair and Rapporteur, in accordance with rule 27, paragraphs 5 and 6, of the draft rules of procedure of the COP being applied.
