# Second meeting of the Adaptation Committee Bonn, Germany 5–8 March 2013

Pursuant to decisions 1/CP.16 and 2/CP.17, I am pleased to notify constituencies of admitted non-governmental organizations that the second meeting of the Adaptation Committee will take place at the United Nations Campus (also known as "Langer Eugen"), in Bonn, Germany, from 5–8 March 2013.

In accordance with the modalities and procedures adopted by decision 2/CP.17, the meeting of the Adaptation Committee will be open to admitted observer organizations, except where otherwise decided by the Adaptation Committee. Given space limitations, participation will be limited to two representatives by constituency.

Representatives from NGOs nominated by the Constituency Focal Point must register for the meeting using the Observer Registration Form for NGOs, which is sent to Constituency Focal Points. Confirmation by the Constituency Focal Point is provided for in the form. The deadline for registration as an observer is <u>Friday</u>, 15 February 2013.
