#### **MESSAGE TO PARTIES**

### Early submission of information and views

This note contains an updated table listing upcoming deadlines for submission of information and views invited by Convention and Kyoto Protocol bodies. The note has been prepared as a reference for Parties to facilitate the early submission of information and views. The update reflects the outcomes of the recent sessions of the Conference of the Parties (COP), Conference of the Parties serving as the Meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI), Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA), Ad Hoc Working Group on Longterm Cooperative Action under the Convention (AWG-LCA) and the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP). Where the reports of the sessions are not yet ready the table refers to the appropriate in-session documents.

In order for documents to be produced in a timely manner and to facilitate preparations, it is important that the submissions reach the secretariat on time. Electronic submissions, either on CD-ROM or sent via e-mail, will facilitate the timely production of documents. E-mail submissions should be sent to <a href="mailto:secretariat@unfccc.int">secretariat@unfccc.int</a>; receipt will be acknowledged. Submissions formatted in MS Word 2000 are preferable. If non-electronic submissions are provided, more time will be needed to produce the document.

As submissions are compiled on an issue-by-issue basis, Parties are requested to identify each submission by its subject and mandate and, if possible, send each submission as a separate document.
