INFORMATION NOTE

I am pleased to inform Parties, observer States and observer organizations to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and its Kyoto Protocol that the Bureau of COP 16 and CMP 6 met on 25 January 2011 and decided to convene the following meetings at the United Nations Conference Centre (UNCC) of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP), Rajdamnern Nok Avenue, Bangkok 10200, Thailand, from 3 to 8 April 2011;

- The sixteenth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol;
- The fourteenth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action under the Convention;
- Workshops pursuant to the Cancun Agreements and to other decisions as appropriate.

Taking into consideration the availability of premises, the Bureau also recommended that the above-mentioned sessions be preceded by preparatory meetings of the Group of 77 and China, the African Group, the small island developing States and the least developed countries from 30 March to 2 April 2011.

The official notification and the provisional agendas for the sessions will be issued in due course.
