Ad Hoc Working Group on the Paris Agreement

Pre-sessional workshop on agenda item 4: Further guidance in relation to the adaptation communication¹

6 May 2017, Bonn, Germany

Pursuant to the request by the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Paris Agreement (APA) at the second part of the first session, I am pleased to notify Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) that the pre-sessional workshop under APA agenda item 4 (Further guidance in relation to the adaptation communication, including, inter alia, as a component of nationally determined contributions, referred to in Article 7, paragraphs 10 and 11, of the Paris Agreement) will take place in Bonn, Germany, on **6 May 2017**. The date of the round table was determined by Parties in Marrakech and it is reflected in the planning of pre-sessional group meetings.
