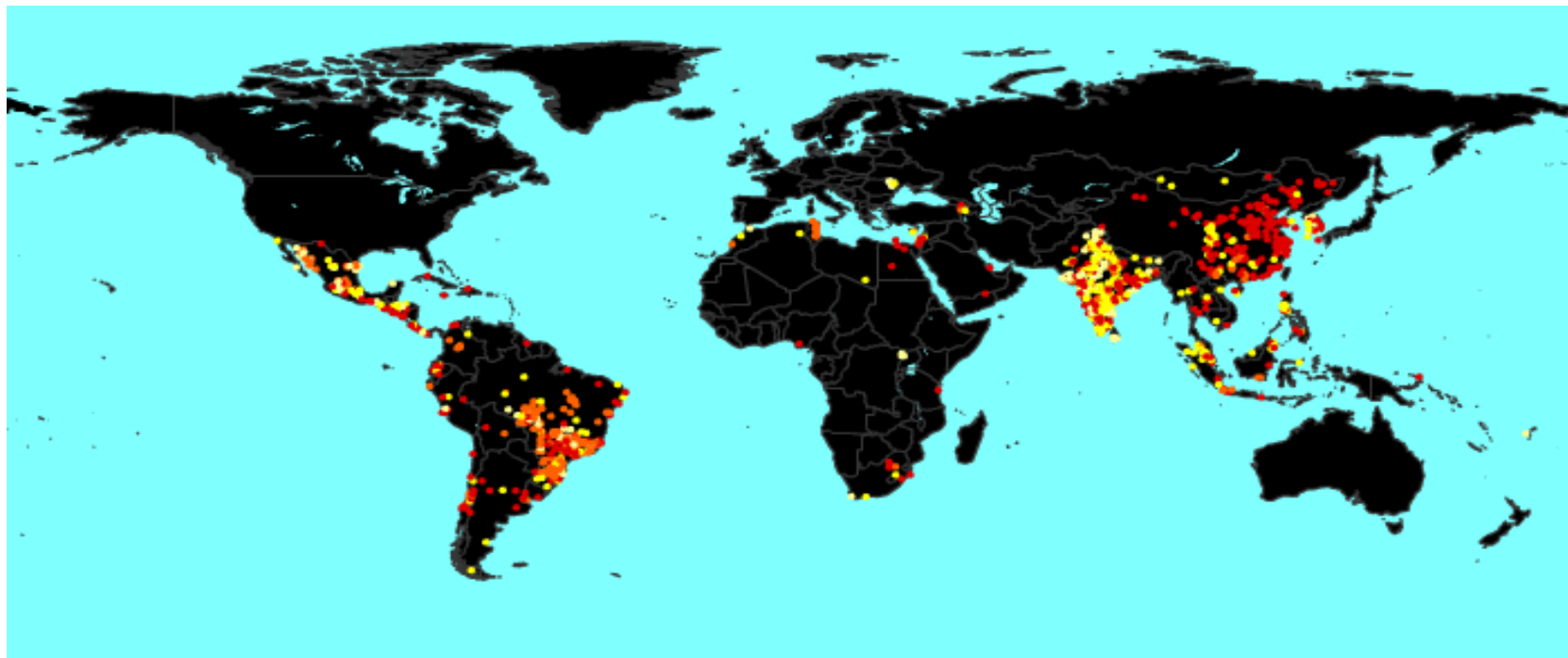


A MECHANISM WITH GLOBAL REACH

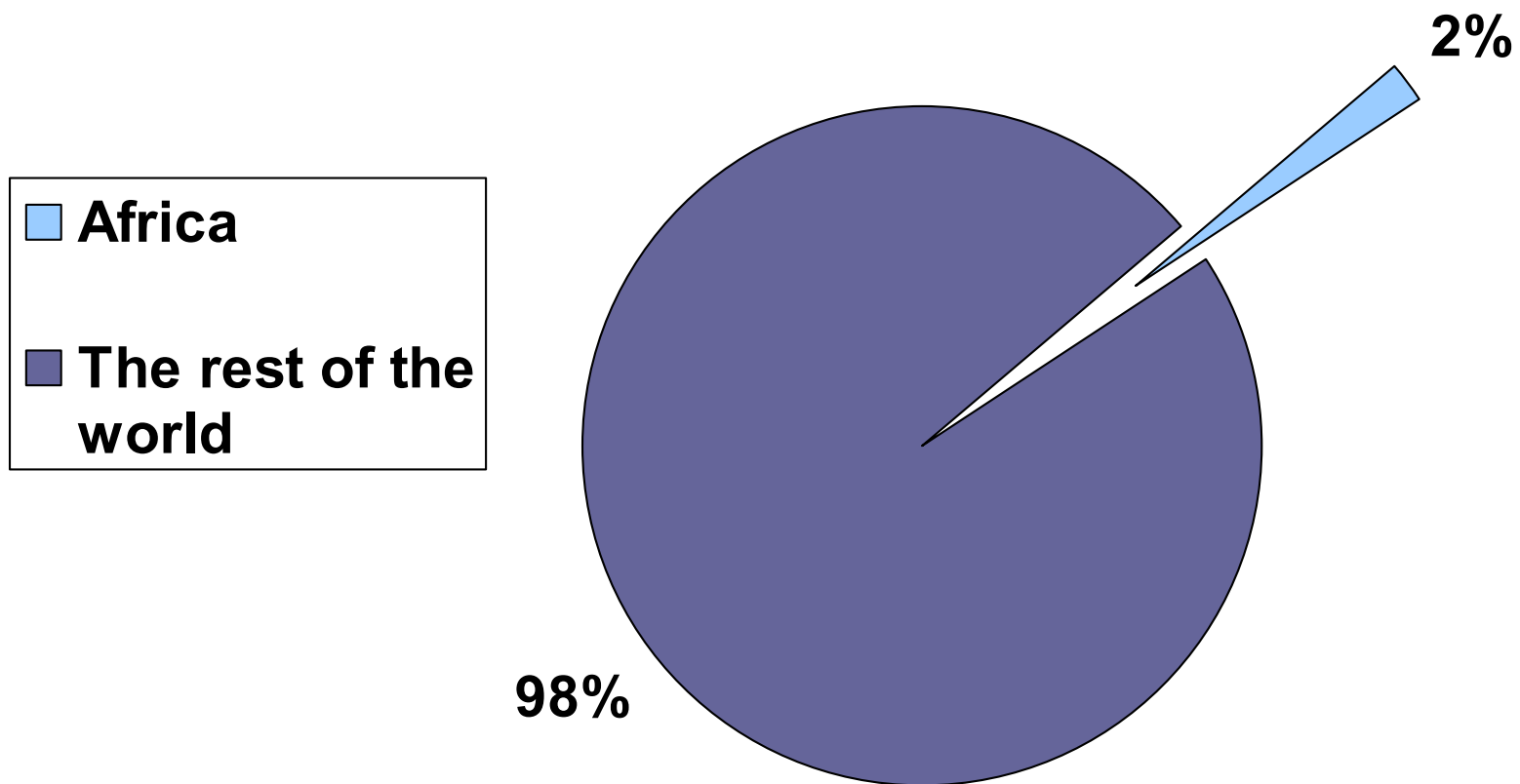
- >3,600 registered projects in 72 countries
- 13 programmes of activities registered
- >3,600 projects in validation/registration pipeline
- > 778 million CERs issued

>2.7 billion CERs estimated in pipeline; >1 billion to be issued to end of 2012
