I. Opening of the session

1. The first part of the sixth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP) was held at the Accra International Conference Centre, Accra, Ghana, from 21 to 27 August 2008.
2. The Chair of the AWG-KP, Mr. Harald Dovland (Norway), opened the session and welcomed all Parties and observers. He also welcomed Mr. Mama Konate (Mali) as Vice-Chair and Mr. Chan-Woo Kim (Republic of Korea)¹ as Rapporteur of the AWG-KP.
