## Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

- 1. The Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP) initiated its consideration of information on potential environmental, economic and social consequences, including spillover effects, of tools, policies, measures and methodologies available to Annex I Parties. The AWG-KP took note of the deliberations on this matter and was encouraged by the constructive discussions.
- 2. The AWG-KP took note of the views submitted by Parties on this matter in response to the request made at its resumed fourth session.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. The AWG-KP invited Parties and relevant organizations to submit to the secretariat, by 3 October 2008, further information on the potential environmental, economic and social consequences, including spillover effects, of tools, policies, measures and methodologies available to Annex I Parties. The AWG-KP requested the secretariat to compile the submissions into a miscellaneous document for consideration at its resumed sixth session (December 2008).
- 4. The AWG-KP requested the secretariat to organize, as part of its programme of work for 2009 and under the guidance of the Chair of the AWG-KP, a workshop on this matter, taking into account the miscellaneous document mentioned in paragraph 3 above.
- 5. The AWG-KP agreed to continue its consideration of this matter at its resumed sixth session.
