Status report on the review of fourth national communications

## Status of submission and review of fourth national communications and of reports demonstrating progress

## Note by the secretariat

- 1. This note provides information on the status of submission and review of fourth national communications, and of reports demonstrating progress under the Kyoto Protocol, from Parties included in Annex I to the Convention (Annex I Parties).
- 2. The Conference of the Parties (COP), by its decisions 4/CP.8 and 22/CP.7, requested that fourth national communications and reports demonstrating progress be submitted to the secretariat by 1 January 2006. The COP, by its decision 4/CP.8, requested the secretariat to continue to apply the procedures for review of national communications, including in-depth reviews, as defined by decisions 2/CP.1, 6/CP.3 and 11/CP.4. In addition, decision 7/CP.11 requested the secretariat to organize a centralized review of fourth national communications, submitted in accordance with decision 4/CP.8, and to conduct an in-country, in-depth review of the fourth national communication for those Parties that request one. Decisions 22/CMP.1 and 25/CP.8 set out the procedures for the review of national communications and reports demonstrating progress for Annex I Parties that are also Parties to the Kyoto Protocol.
- 3. At the time of the preparation of this note, and as shown in the table below, the secretariat had received 40 fourth national communications<sup>1</sup> and 35 reports demonstrating progress under the Kyoto Protocol. All national communications and reports demonstrating progress under the Kyoto Protocol received so far have been posted on the UNFCCC website.<sup>2</sup>

- 4. The secretariat coordinated three centralized reviews of fourth national communications and reports demonstrating progress under the Kyoto Protocol, from 5 to 10 June 2006, from 16 to 21 October 2006 and from 12 to 17 May 2008, in Bonn, Germany. It also coordinated in-country, in-depth reviews of the fourth national communications of Australia, Turkey and the United States of America. To date, fourth national communications from 29 Parties have been reviewed by international teams of experts and 26 reports of in-depth reviews of national communications have been published on the UNFCCC website.<sup>3</sup>
- 5. Eleven in-depth reviews of fourth national communications are still pending and could take place during 2009, subject to availability of resources. Timely organization of these reviews is important in order to provide feedback that Parties could take it into consideration when preparing the next national communication. Decision 10/CP.13 requests Annex I Parties to submit their fifth national communication by 1 January 2010. Decision 8/CMP.3 requests Annex I Parties that are also Parties to the Kyoto Protocol to include in the fifth national communications submitted under the Convention and decision 10/CP.13, the necessary supplementary information under the guidelines established under Article 7 of the Kyoto Protocol.
