II. Annotations to the provisional agenda

1. Opening of the session

(Agenda item 1)

1. The seventh session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP) will be opened by the Chair on Sunday, 29 March 2009, at 3 p.m. at the Maritim Hotel in Bonn, Germany.

2. Organizational matters

(Agenda item 2)

(a) <u>Adoption of the agenda</u>

2. The provisional agenda for the session will be presented for adoption. Parties will be invited to make any general statements after the adoption of the agenda.

(b) <u>Organization of the work of the session</u>

3. *Background*: At its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP confirmed that it would hold its seventh session from 29 March to 8 April 2009 in Bonn, Germany.¹

4. The Chair of the AWG-KP will issue a scenario note to share with Parties proposals for the organization of work for the seventh session. This note will also provide information on the organization of in-depth consultations on emissions trading and the project-based mechanisms, and land use, land-use change and forestry, as well as on the workshops referred to in paragraphs 13 and 26 below.

5. Parties are invited to refer to the overview of the session posted on the UNFCCC website and to consult the Daily Programme, published during the session, for a detailed and up-to-date schedule of the work of the AWG-KP.

6. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI), at its twenty-fourth session,² recommended that meetings should normally end by 6 p.m. but may, in exceptional circumstances, continue no later than 9 p.m. The session will be organized accordingly.

7. Representatives of Parties and international organizations are requested to keep their oral statements as brief as possible. Those wishing to make a written statement available should bring copies for distribution.

8. *Action*: The AWG-KP will be invited to agree on the approach to the organization of work for the session.

(c) <u>Election of officers</u>

9. *Background*: At the resumed sixth session of the AWG-KP, consultations were undertaken with regional groups on the election of the officers of the AWG-KP. At the final plenary of the fourth session of the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP), the President informed the CMP that consultations had not been completed. Further, that in accordance with rule 22 of the draft rules of procedure of the Conference of the Parties (COP) and its subsidiary bodies being applied, the current officers of the AWG-KP, Mr. Harald Dovland (Norway) as Chair, Mr. Mama Konate (Mali) as Vice-Chair, and Mr. Chan-Woo Kim (Republic of Korea) as Rapporteur, would remain in office until their successors are elected at the next ordinary session of the AWG-KP.³ Parties may note that rule 27 of the draft rules of procedure being applied provides that, unless the COP decides otherwise, the Chair of any subsidiary body other than those established by Articles 9 and 10 of the Convention shall be elected by that subsidiary body from among the representatives of the Parties present at the session, and that each subsidiary body shall elect its own Vice-Chair and Rapporteur.⁴

10. Parties are invited to recall decision 36/CP.7 and to give active consideration to the nomination of women for elective posts in any body established under the Convention or its Kyoto Protocol.

11. *Action*: Following completion of consultations, the AWG-KP will be invited to elect its Chair, Vice-Chair and Rapporteur.

3. Consideration of the scale of emission reductions to be achieved by Annex I Parties in aggregate (Agenda item 3)

4. Contribution of Annex I Parties, individually or jointly, to the scale of emission reductions to be achieved by Annex I Parties in aggregate (Agenda item 4)

12. *Background*: At its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP agreed to adopt conclusions on the consideration of the scale of emission reductions to be achieved by Annex I Parties in aggregate and to reach conclusion on a draft amendment text. It requested its Chair to prepare:

- (a) A note on possible elements for amendments, pursuant to Article 3, paragraph 9, of the Kyoto Protocol, for consideration at its seventh session;
- (b) A note on possible elements of a text relating to issues outlined in paragraph 49 of document FCCC/KP/AWG/2008/8.⁵

13. Also at its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP requested the secretariat to organize, under the guidance of the Chair of the AWG-KP, a workshop on issues relating to the scale of emission reductions to be considered by Annex I Parties in aggregate and on the contribution of Annex I Parties individually or jointly, to this scale.⁶ The workshop has been scheduled as a pre-sessional event on Friday, 27 March 2009.⁷

14. The AWG-KP invited Parties to submit to the secretariat, by 15 February 2009, their views on these matters.

15. *Action*: The AWG-KP will be invited to adopt conclusions on the scale of emission reductions to be achieved by Annex I Parties in aggregate, and to reach conclusion on a draft amendment text. The AWG-KP will also be invited to consider the notes referred to in paragraph 12 (a) and (b) above with a view to:

- (a) Ensuring that the text for any proposed amendments is communicated by the secretariat to Parties no later than six months prior to the proposed adoption of the amendments, with a view to such amendments being adopted by the CMP at its fifth session;
- (b) Developing a text on the issues outlined to in paragraph 49 of document FCCC/KP/AWG/2008/8 by June 2009 for adoption by the CMP at its fifth session.

5. Other issues arising from the implementation of the work programme of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (Agenda item 5)

(a) <u>Emissions trading and the project-based mechanisms</u>

16. *Background*: The AWG-KP, at its resumed sixth session, agreed to continue, including through in-depth consultations at its seventh session, its deliberations on the possible improvements to emissions trading and the project-based mechanisms identified in annexes I and II to the report on the first part of its sixth session, with the focus on those in annex I and avoiding duplication of work in its consideration of those in annex II.

17. Pre-sessional, in-depth consultations on this issue have been scheduled for Thursday, 26 March 2009.⁸

18. Also at its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP requested its Chair to further elaborate the possible improvements to emissions trading and the project-based mechanisms in order to facilitate the consultations referred to in paragraphs 16 and 17 above. It invited Parties to submit to the secretariat, by 6 February 2009, further input on how the possible improvements to emissions trading and the project-based mechanisms would function.⁹

19. *Action*: The AWG-KP will be invited to consider the information referred to in paragraph 18 above and to advance work on these issues with a view to accomplishing the tasks referred to in paragraph 15 (a) and (b) above.

(b) Land use, land-use change and forestry

20. *Background*: At its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP agreed to continue, including through in-depth consultations at its seventh session, its deliberations on how to address, where applicable, the definitions, modalities, rules and guidelines for the treatment of land use, land-use change and forestry.

21. Pre-sessional, in-depth consultations on this issue have been scheduled for Thursday, 26 March 2009.¹⁰

22. In order to facilitate the consultations referred in paragraphs 20 and 21 above, the AWG-KP requested its Chair to elaborate, taking into account decision 16/CMP.1, the options, elements and issues contained in annex III to the report of the AWG-KP at its resumed sixth session, annex IV to the report of the AWG-KP at its resumed fifth session, the information submitted on a voluntary and informal basis to the secretariat, and any further information submitted by Parties, for consideration by the AWG-KP at its seventh session.¹¹

23. The AWG-KP invited Parties to submit, by 15 February 2009, their views and proposals for further elaboration of the options, elements and issues contained in annex III to the report of the AWG-KP at its resumed sixth session and annex IV to the report of the AWG-KP at its resumed fifth session.¹²

24. *Action*: The AWG-KP will be invited to consider the information referred to in paragraphs 22 and 23 above. It will also be invited to advance work on these issues with a view to accomplishing the tasks referred to in paragraph 15 (a) and (b) above.

Consideration of information on potential environmental, economic and social consequences, (c) including spillover effects, of tools, policies, measures and methodologies available to Annex I Parties

Background: At its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP agreed to continue its consideration of 25. the potential environmental, economic and social consequences, including spillover effects, of tools, policies, measures and methodologies available to Annex I Parties (hereafter referred to as potential consequences) at its seventh session. It also invited Parties to submit to the secretariat, by 15 February 2009, their views on these issues.¹³

26. Also at its resumed sixth session, the AWG-KP requested the secretariat to organize, at its seventh session and under the guidance of its Chair, an in-session workshop on potential consequences and to prepare an information note to facilitate deliberations at this workshop.¹⁴ The workshop is scheduled for Monday, 30 March 2009.¹⁵

Action: The AWG-KP will be invited to adopt conclusions on potential consequences and to 27. agree on further work with a view to accomplishing the tasks referred to in paragraph 15 (a) and (b) above.
