## II. Background

- 1. The Ad Hoc Working Group on Further Commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol (AWG-KP), at its resumed fourth session, agreed that its main task for its seventh and eighth sessions was to forward the results of its work to the Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) at its fifth session, with a view to their adoption.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. The CMP, by its decision 1/CMP.5, requested the AWG-KP to deliver the results of its work pursuant to decision 1/CMP.1 for adoption by the CMP at its sixth session.
- 3. At its first meeting in 2010, the Bureau of the Conference of the Parties (COP) at its fifteenth session and the CMP at its fifth session decided that the eleventh session of the AWG-KP will be held in Bonn, Germany, from 9 to 11 April 2010, in conjunction with the ninth session of the Ad Hoc Working Group on Long-term Cooperative Action under the Convention (AWG-LCA).

## III. Annotations to the provisional agenda

#### 1. Opening of the session

4. The eleventh session of the AWG-KP will be opened by the Chair on Friday, 9 April 2010, at the Maritim Hotel in Bonn.

#### 2. Organizational matters

- 5. The provisional agenda for the session will be presented for adoption. Parties will be invited to make any general statements after the adoption of the agenda.

- (b) <u>Organization of the work of the session</u>
- 6. *Background*: The Chair of the AWG-KP has prepared a note (FCCC/KP/AWG/2010/2) on the scenario for the eleventh session. Delegates are invited to consult this scenario note for further information and proposals on the organization of work.
- 7. The AWG-KP will meet in an opening plenary on Friday, 9 April. The Chair will invite statements on behalf of groups of Parties. Delegations are requested to keep their oral statements as brief as possible and to give a hard copy to the conference officers in advance to facilitate the work of the interpreters. Those wishing to make a written statement available to all delegates should bring copies for distribution.
- 8. Parties are invited to refer to the overview of the session posted on the UNFCCC website and to consult the Daily Programme, published during the session, for a detailed and up-to-date schedule of the work of the AWG-KP.
- 9. The Subsidiary Body for Implementation, at its twenty-fourth session, recommended that meetings should normally end by 6 p.m. but may, in exceptional circumstances, continue no later than 9 p.m. This session of the AWG-KP will be organized accordingly.

10. Action: The AWG-KP will be invited to agree on the organization of work for the session.

#### (c) <u>Election of officers</u>

- 11. *Background*: The AWG-KP is expected to elect a Chair, Vice-Chair and Rapporteur for 2010. Pursuant to rule 27, paragraph 5, of the draft rules of procedure being applied,<sup>2</sup> the Chair of any subsidiary body other than those established by Articles 9 and 10 of the Convention, shall be elected by that subsidiary body from among the representatives of the Parties present at the session, unless the COP decides otherwise. Rule 27 also provides that each subsidiary body shall elect its own Vice-Chair and Rapporteur and that the officers shall be elected with due regard to the principle of equitable geographical representation and shall not serve more than two consecutive terms of one year.
- 12. In accordance with practice, consultations on the election of officers will be undertaken under the authority of the President of COP 15 and CMP 5. Parties are invited to recall decision 36/CP.7 and to give active consideration to the nomination of women for elective posts in any body established under the Convention or its Kyoto Protocol. The current officers of the AWG-KP will remain in office until their successors are elected.
- 13. *Action*: Following completion of consultations, the AWG-KP will be invited to elect its Chair, Vice-Chair and Rapporteur.

#### 3. Consideration of further commitments for Annex I Parties under the Kyoto Protocol

- 14. *Background*: The CMP, by its decision 1/CMP.5, requested the AWG-KP to deliver the results of its work pursuant to decision 1/CMP.1 for adoption by the CMP at its sixth session, and to continue its work drawing on the draft text forwarded as part of its report on its tenth session to the CMP at its fifth session.
- 15. The report of the AWG-KP on its tenth session containing the draft decisions presented to the CMP at its fifth session for consideration and adoption has been issued as document FCCC/KP/AWG/2009/17.
- 16. *Action*: The AWG-KP will be invited to consider how to ensure that work on all outstanding issues be concluded by the end of 2010, including the need for any technical input to support this work.

#### 4. Work programme for 2010

17. *Background*: The Chair of the AWG-KP and the Chair of the AWG-LCA jointly invited Parties to submit their views on the need for additional meeting time of the ad hoc working groups in 2010.<sup>3</sup> The submissions have been compiled into a miscellaneous document for the session.<sup>4</sup>
