**GEF Submission to the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), on Article 6.**

At the 34th Session of the Subsidiary Bodies of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) further invited the GEF and its implementing agencies to provide to the SBI at its thirty-fifth session information on resources made available for the implementation of Article 6 related activities for consideration at its thirty-sixth session.

To date we have had consultations with eight (8) of the GEF Agencies on eight hundred and fifty one (851) projects. The initial estimate is that a minimum of US\$84,301,200 has been allocated to finance Article 6 activities, since the inception of the GEF. The GEF will continue to work with the agencies on this issue and provide a revised figure for SBI thirty six.
