Draft conclusions proposed by the Chair

1. The Subsidiary Body for Scientific and Technological Advice (SBSTA) noted with appreciation the information paper¹ prepared by the secretariat to summarize cooperative activities and efforts by United Nations entities and other intergovernmental organizations to contribute to the work of the Convention.
2. The SBSTA took note of the focus of the cooperative activities and initiatives currently being undertaken by the secretariat with the support of the United Nations system and other intergovernmental organizations to ensure effective implementation of the Convention.
3. The SBSTA also took note of the statements by the secretariats of the Convention on Biological Diversity and the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification on their activities and efforts to address climate change and on their contribution to the work of the Convention.
