**Privileges and immunities for individuals serving on
constituted bodies established under the Kyoto Protocol**

Proposal by the President

1. The Conference of the Parties serving as the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP) took note of the conclusions of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI) on this matter.¹
2. The CMP also took note of the draft treaty arrangements on privileges and immunities for individuals serving on constituted bodies established under the Kyoto Protocol that were forwarded by the SBI.²
3. The CMP requested the SBI, at its thirty-eighth session, to continue its consideration of this matter and to report to the CMP, at its ninth session, on the outcome of its work.
4. The CMP invited the Conference of the Parties to consider whether privileges and immunities for individuals serving on bodies established under the Convention may be required, taking into account the work undertaken by the SBI on this matter.
5. The CMP decided to continue its consideration of this matter at its next session.
