At COP 20 in December 2014 in Lima, the Executive Secretary of the UNFCCC and the Presidency of COP 21 were encouraged to convene a high-level event to enhance the implementation of climate action.

Answering this call and building on the catalysing effect of the United Nations Secretary-General's Climate Summit in September 2014 and the work undertaken by Peru, France, the Executive Office of the United Nations Secretary-General and the UNFCCC, the Action Day highlights the existing momentum for scaled-up engagement by State and non-State actors and shows the necessity for and feasibility and power of multi-stakeholder climate action. It will gather more than fifty high-level speakers and showcase their most emblematic commitments.
