

#### **Transport Services**

#### Public Transport

The Government of France provides free 'Navigo' local transportation passes to each accredited participant (oneweek passes for registered representatives of observer organizations for each week they are accredited for and twoweek passes for all other accredited participants). The pass allows to use all public transportation within Paris and from Roissy to Paris or Le Bourget (and vice versa), including the RER, Metro, and the following buses:

<u>Bus n° 152</u>, stop "Michelet–Parc des Expositions" (very useful for the Le Bourget Hotel area) <u>Bus n° 350</u>, stop "Michelet–Parc des Expositions" <u>Noctilien n° 42</u> (all night bus), stop "Le Bourget"

'Navigo' passes can be picked up at the Transportation desk located beside the registration counter, upon presentation of a valid conference badge. Transportation desk opening hours are 30 November to 13 December from 08.00 a.m. to 07.00 p.m.

Bluebus Shuttle
